Why should I bother to be more religious? I’m a good person. Isn’t that enough to get me into heaven?

When asked for advice about how people should decide on a vocation, St. Ignatius Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits, said they should do an imagination exercise. “Imagine that you are on your deathbed,” he said. “From that point of view what would you wish you had done in your life?” That is still good advice.

Here’s another exercise: Imagine you have a grandmother who is completely generous and caring toward you. Throughout your childhood, she was always there for you. But as a teen you belittled her and, in effect, told her that all she had offered is worthless to you. In a saner moment, won’t you feel terrible about how you treated her?

Our life with God is much the same. God has given us absolutely everything, from our existence to every breath we take. God has also given us a way to know him through his Son, Jesus (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 73). And one way we know Jesus is through the Church and the celebration of the sacraments (CCC 1085). To refuse these gifts, to say, “I am already a good person. I don’t need these gifts from God” is a bit presumptuous, don’t you think?

To be “religious” is not just an outward show of piety. It’s the way we have been given to learn God’s language: the language of forgiveness, of faith, hope,and love.

THOUGHTS ON LENT

Examples on Good Stewardship during Lent: 1. Attempt a more intentional prayer life-start a habit in the morning and before bedtime. Embrace periods of silence each day. 2. Read a book on Christian spirituality that can enrich your Lenten journey or consider keeping a Lenten journal so you can reflect on your highs and lows. 3. Attend a weekday Mass. 4. Pray the rosary. 5. Experience the Sacrament of Reconciliation. 6. Give up meat on Fridays but don’t substitute lobster. Make fasting something truly sacrificial. 7. Stop engaging in rumors, gossip and negative chatter that devalues others. 8. Begin and end each week with an email thanking someone for all that they do. 9. Be sure to say grace at any restaurant you frequent; including the Sign of the Cross. 10. Reconcile with someone you’ve hurt or aren’t speaking to.
