MONSIGNOR DEROUEN'S REMARKS AT HIS 40TH ANNIVERSARY

When Msgr. Gouaux was named as a Monsignor, at the Mass of investiture he said, "How sweet it is!", invoking those famous words of Jackie Gleason. Today, I can say the same, "How sweet it is!"

But this sweetness, for which I am today most grateful is not because of the accomplishment of 40 years in the priesthood because a better response to that would be "Oh my goodness, that's a long time!" I say "How sweet it is!" because of what those 40 years have taught me to see and cherish- "How sweet it is to be loved by you!", as Marvin Gaye sang in the 1960's and James Taylor's remake in the year I graduated from Teurlings in 1975.

How sweet it is to be loved by you! And the You are many.

My brother priests here today; Whitney who preached as only he can. Thank you ever so much. Jace & Mikel, other members of my support group, Ken, himself a jubilarian this year- but as you can see he is much older – he celebrates his 50th. How sweet it is to be

Kaplan, my first pastoral experience as a seminarian and St. Edmond's in Lafayette where I was a Deacon, St. Mary Magdalen in Abbeville, my first assignment as a priest where I learned to appreciate the beauty of Catholic schools, teaching Juniors at V.C. Then St. Michael's in Crowley, probably the most fun I had in the 40 years. I wasn't a new priest- afraid of everything; I wasn't a pastor – worried about everything. I just smiled and waved, and played and taught some classes at Notre Dame and Crowley High School – how sweet it is to be loved by you.

Then the path of pastorhood began, and how privileged I was to be sent to the first parish of the Diocese – the Mother of the Acadians, St. Martin de Tours in St. Martinville. How sweet it is to be loved by you.

Then Cathedral – epicenter of the Diocese – and in the Church today are 2 former rectors and liturgists of their respective Dioceses-Msgr. Hedrick from the Archdiocese of New Orleans & Msgr. Eskind from the Diocese of Lake Charles. Cathedrals are different parishes, but how I came to love its parishioners, the school, the beauty – how sweet it is to be loved by you.

And now here at Our Lady Queen of Angels for more years than anywhere else in my entire life except my first 14 years with family, but even those 14 years saw various residences: Avery Island, where I was born, Charles St. in New Iberia, Lee St. in New Iberia then back to Charles St. then I left for seminary at 14. I have lived in that house across the way longer than any other house in my 66 ½ years with you, with an amazing staff in the office, maintenance and the house; with amazing

Missing him today and feeling it deeply is Msgr. Paul Metrejean, Fr. Met, as I have enshrined him in my heart's memory. When he died 3 years ago, I felt the rudder of the ship that is my priesthood was destroyed. But I have come to see – it's not destroyed, it's changed and I can still say about him, and to him, "How sweet it is to be loved by you!"

And my family - Momma & Daddy have been in Heaven well over 4 decades now, and Jerry only since 2014. But before Jerry died, he and Bonnie made a family of 4 and that has grown into 16 today.

Catherine, my beautiful sister and only sister and her husband, Mac, my favorite brother-in-law made a family of 4 and that has grown into a family of 20. Catherine though she looks younger, is actually older and was for me a second momma – and still is for Mark & me.

Mark, the brother just before me and his wife Sandra, who keeps us in stitches all the time with her sparkly glasses and Easter bunny costumes, made a family of 2 which today is a family of 11. You may recognize Mark from TV as he has been in the news since his dental office was destroyed in a tornado. But he and Sandra have recovered and in practice again.

How blessed we are that we are still able to get together and have fun... How sweet it is to be loved by you.

And then there's the Lord Jesus- "How sweet it is to be loved by you. You have been better to me than I am to myself... For me there's You and there ain't nobody else...So I want to stop and thank you Jesus, I just wanna stop and thank you Jesus, and say over and over again- How Sweet It Is To Be Loved By You."
