Are we supposed to pray a specific prayer after we genuflect and kneel in the pew before we take our seats? What about after Communion?

There is no particular prayer to say when we genuflect, enter the pew, and kneel for a while. Genuflecting and kneeling are powerful expressions and prayers in themselves—we kneel only to God. But these gestures can become mere routine unless we accompany them with a moment of awareness and recollection and maybe a prayer like, “I adore you, O Christ, and I bless you, because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.”

Neither are there required prayers to say in the moments after holy Communion as we return to the pew. But this is a most special time. “Holy souls endeavor to remain as long as possible in prayer after Communion,” wrote St. Alphonsus Liguori in *The Holy Eucharist*. “There is no prayer more agreeable to God, or more profitable to the soul, than that which is made during the thanksgiving after Communion.” Eucharist is from the Greek *eukharistia*, which means “thanksgiving,” and this is a time for giving thanks. We remain silently focused on the astonishing passion and affection of our Lord in giving himself to us to eat and make part of ourselves. So much depends on awareness; so much depends on gratitude. Prayer books may help us enter a time of thanksgiving. But we can also say simply, “Jesus, I love you.”

DID YOU KNOW?

How might I invite a non-Catholic to join our Catholic Faith or a Baptized Catholic to receive the Sacraments to allow for full participation in the Catholic Faith?

Here are four effective ways to bring people into the fullness of the Catholic Faith. (Source pintswithaquinas.com)

Understand who you're evangelizing

Adapt your message to your audience. Learn about your listeners — their hopes, fears, pain points, and level of knowledge. You're not selling anything but inviting people to a personal relationship with Christ.

Share the impact being Catholic has had on your life. Tell people how being Catholic has impacted your life, Focus on relationship evangelization. This is usually always more effective than intellectual debate. Share concrete examples of how being Catholic has transformed your life for the better. You may awaken something in your listeners that makes them long for such a beautiful relationship with Christ!

Love them and be patient

You have to start with loving them. Begin with love and let the intellectual part naturally flow out of this. If you start by criticizing them, they'll shut down. Start with love, and you'll be amazed by how many people open themselves up to the truth. Conversion is rarely instantaneous; it's usually a step-by-step process. You need to be there encouraging (but not rushing) them every step of the way.

Above all, PRAY

It is ultimately the Holy Spirit who converts hearts. We merely plant the seeds. As soon as you try to take a person's conversion fully into your own hands, you've set yourself up for failure. Pray to the Holy Spirit, the Blessed Mother, and the Saints. After you've done your part sharing your faith, loving, and praying, leave the rest up to God.
