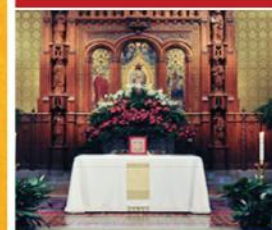

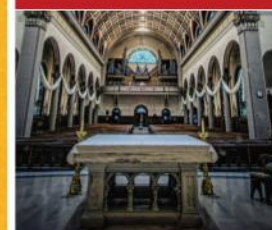

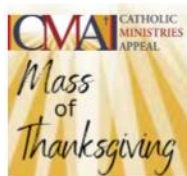

Considering the changes to the Mass schedule, and upcoming changes to the way that intentions will be remembered at Mass, it is important to keep in mind the nature and purpose of Mass intentions. There are fewer Masses being celebrated, and therefore fewer opportunities for Mass intentions. One solution to this is to have multiple intentions for each Mass. Although the office will be accepting three intentions per Mass, the Church's law requires that no more than two Masses per week, typically, may be celebrated with multiple intentions. Some folks might be wondering, why is Mass offered for a particular intention? Can't we pray for anything at Mass? So why is there typically only one intention per Mass? And is the offering of money that accomplishes a Mass intention request necessary, and is it like "buying" a Mass?

The practice of offering a Mass for a particular intention is a very ancient one, which goes back at least to the Second Century AD. The most common example of a Mass intention, and the oldest recorded Mass intention in history, is for the repose of the faithful departed.

To understand Mass intentions, it is important to remember what the Mass is, and to understand its value and application. The Mass is a sacrifice, which makes Jesus' sacrifice of Himself upon the Cross present to us in an unbloody manner. Since the Mass is one and the same act as the Cross, each celebration of Mass shares in the infinite value and merit of Jesus' self-sacrifice to the Father. Thus, each Mass is as valuable as the death of Jesus on the Cross; it is the same event but presented in a different way. The Mass has fruits that flow to the people from the infinite value of the Sacrifice. One of these fruits is the "ministerial fruit" or the intention of the Mass. As Saint Paul says, the priest is the dispenser or minister of the grace of God, and so it is the priest's intention at Mass that applies the benefits of each Mass to a particular recipient. These, then, are the "intentions" that are listed in the parish bulletin and sometimes announced at Mass.

The Mass doesn't just benefit the person for whom the Mass is offered, however. In addition to the ministerial fruit of the Mass, i.e., the particular intention, there are also general and personal fruits that flow from the Mass. The general fruit of the Mass is the outpouring of grace upon the whole world generally from the Heart of Christ on the Cross. All Christians and all humanity receive some grace from each Mass. How much we receive from the general fruit of the Mass, which is infinite, depends upon how well disposed we are to receive God's grace. And the personal fruit of the Mass consists of God's blessings upon those who attend in person and take part in the worship offered to God. As common sense would suspect, one receives more grace from attending Mass reverently and devoutly, than if one does not attend, or does not attend well.

The "ministerial fruit," that is, the intention of that celebration of the Mass, is the value of the Sacrifice of the Cross applied to a specific person (or persons, or a general cause) by the priest as he offers the Mass. Because the grace of the Mass is infinite, the fact that the priest has an intention does not prohibit the faithful from exercising their share in the priesthood and praying for other intentions as well (i.e., the "personal fruit"). Typically, the parish asks for a small offering for each Mass intention that a person requests. Offerings are not required, and they are not a "price" for the Mass, which is of infinite value and cannot be bought. These offerings are an opportunity for the faithful to make an offering in union with Christ's offering on the Cross, by giving some of their possessions for the support of the Church. They are small, so that all can afford them, and no priest can enrich himself from them. Thus, Mass intentions are a precious gift, because the intention of the Mass is an important way of uniting ourselves to Christ on the Cross and receiving and sharing the precious fruits of the Sacrifice.

SAFEPARISH ACCOUNT USERS – MANDATED

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT – The Archdiocese of Cincinnati, in keeping with its policies, has completed the five-year revision of the Decree on Child Protection. Each user with

a SafeParish account will need to download, acknowledge to have read, and agree to abide by the requirements of the revised Decree. If this is not completed within 30 days of the promulgation of the Decree by the Archbishop, the user's SafeParish account will show as pending until the user completes the acknowledgement. Users with pending SafeParish accounts are not permitted to work or volunteer with youth until they have met all the child protection requirements and their SafeParish account is approved. Please contact your parish or school safe environment coordinator with any questions. **Second Quarter Safe Parish Video Bulletin Now Available:** In order to continue to be approved to volunteer with children in any of the parishes in our family or in any athletic activities sponsored by the parishes, all volunteers must complete the bulletin by **July 30**. 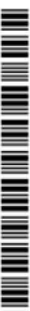
