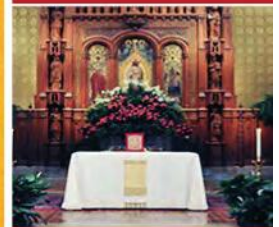

- St. Martin of Tours: upper circle next to church (off of Glenmore Avenue).

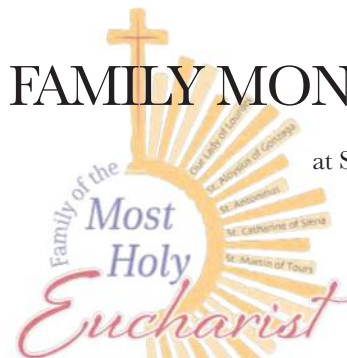
