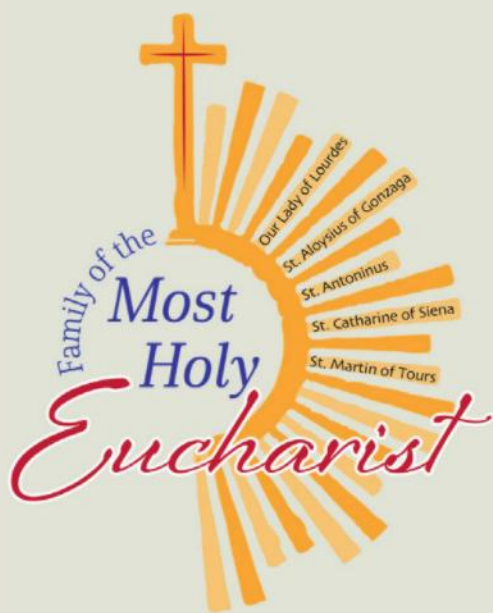

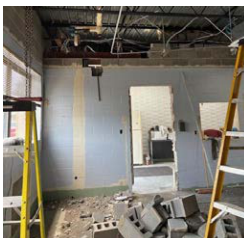
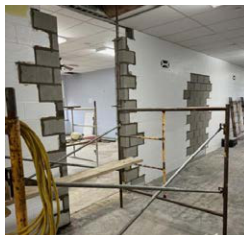
FMHE CENTRALIZED OFFICE

As construction and renovations continue on the new FMHE Parish Office, we have found the need for staff to be localized in one place. Our Lady of Lourdes parish office will act as the temporary FMHE Central Parish Office until the construction is completed. If your parish office is closed and you need help, FMHE Central Office will be open Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

FMHE Parish Office Center Update

The project is moving along smoothly. All the demolition work has been completed. The prep work has been started and a majority of it is completed. Currently, we are in the middle of electrical changes and the painting has started. Once the painting is completed, we will be ready to install the flooring. The next step will be to install the office walls and work stations. A new updated entrance canopy will be constructed shortly.

ST. CATHARINE FACILITIES UPDATE

We continue to keep our grounds and buildings in great condition. The next big project is refurbishment of the 20 stained glass windows in the church. The windows will be removed and relaid as needed and cleaned. One side will be done at a time. The project may start soon, and more information is forthcoming. Here are other projects that have been completed over the past few months:

- Landscaping was updated in the spring.
- The limestone front of the church and school was power washed, tuckpointed, and silicone sealed. The belltower and southwest corner of the church received special attention.
- The roof was repaired, and tile replaced on the south side of the church.
- The roof over the St. Joseph alcove was repaired, and the plaster wall was repaired and painted.
- The rear church door was sealed and repainted.
- The parking lot was resurfaced and repainted.
- Trees were trimmed to enhance appearance and air flow on limestone buildings.
- Parking lot poles and railings were scraped and painted.
- Two new awnings with St. C logos for the front of the school were ordered.
- The security system was updated.
- Enhanced exterior lighting on the buildings was installed.
- The arch over the front door of the church was repaired.

In addition to the windows, upcoming projects include:

- Roof and gutter repair on the sacristy and breezeway to the rectory
- Sidewalk repair in front of the church
- Finish inside repair of the choir loft leakage.

A Note from the Stewardship & Evangelization Office

Happy New Year! I wanted to give an update to you, the Family of the Most Holy Eucharist, about our Family Mondays programming. Family Mondays began as a vision of providing an opportunity for all ages to come together for a meal, and grow in faith through a dynamic presentation. In addition, we wanted to incorporate our PREP program into an opportunity where parents can grow in their faith, while their children are growing in their faith as well. Quite honestly, we weren't sure how well this would take off, but if you have attended one of the Family Mondays dinners and/or speakers, I think you would see a huge success! Each week, we see a wonderful example of how we, 5 parishes, are indeed coming together. It is most definitely a small step, in the right direction.

I've had folks ask me how much these dinners have cost the parish, and whether we will be able to continue this program in the future. At this point, we have held 14 weeks of Family Mondays. The free meals each week have been provided by both catered meals from places like McAlister's, Cane's, LaRosa's, Chipotle, and more; but we've also had amazing donations of breakfast items (Who doesn't like breakfast for dinner?) and delicious soups made by parishioners and brought during Advent.

I am happy to report that we have an average of 97 people attend each week. Families, singles, retirees, children, all are welcome!

The cost of the weekly meals averages \$243.23....that's \$48.65 per parish.

Truly, the Stewardship & Evangelization team could not be happier with how successful these Family Mondays have been!

If you have not attended one of our Family Mondays yet, please come! Family Mondays are open to ALL parishioners in our Family of the Most Holy Eucharist. This is NOT just for parish religious education program (PREP) families and children. It is for everyone! Please join us! You won't be disappointed!!
