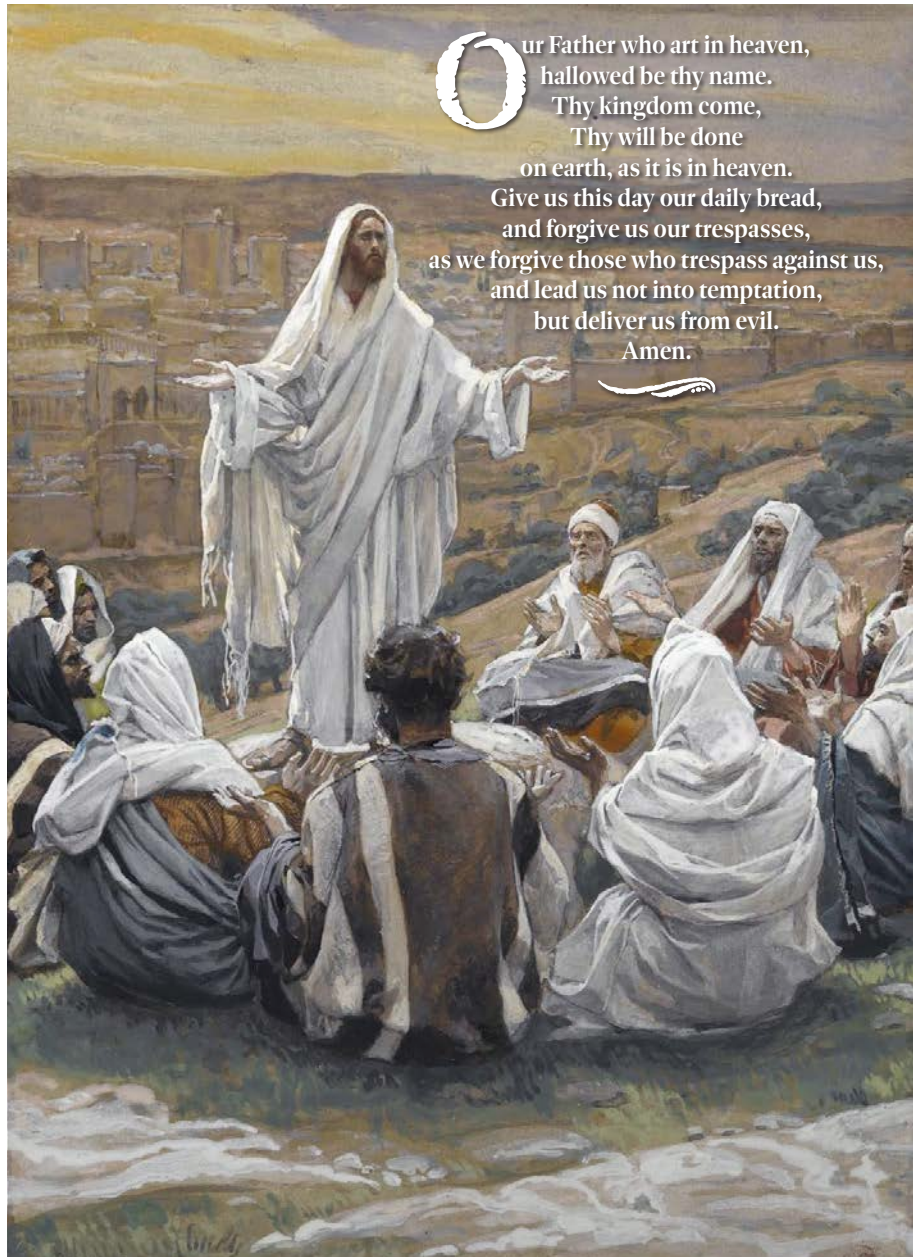

THE SACRAMENTS

Christ instituted the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation, Eucharist, the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony. The seven sacraments touch all the stages and important moments of Christian life. Please find below information on obtaining the sacraments.

BAPTISM: Expectant parents are asked to call the Evangelization office approximately three months before the anticipated birth date to enroll in the parental preparation program. Contact Erin Dwyer at edwyer@fmhe.org with questions.

MATRIMONY: We ask that either the bride or groom be a registered, active parishioner for at least six months before arranging a date for your wedding. To get started in your preparation process, please call the Worship office at least six months before your wedding date. Contact Christy Welsh at Cwelsh@fmhe.org to discuss the marriage preparation process.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: If you are anticipating surgery or have become ill and would like to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact Christy Welsh in the Worship office.

HOLY ORDERS: If you are interested in learning more about the priesthood, please contact Fr. Michael Willig, Archdiocese of Cincinnati Vocations Director, at 513-263-3390 or vocations@catholicaoc.org.

SACRAMENTAL RECORD REQUEST: If you are in need of a sacramental record such as a record of Baptism, Confirmation or Marriage, we now have an easy way for you to make your request at all five parishes! Once the request has been received, please allow 10 business days for processing.

TUNING IN: NOTES FROM THE DIRECTOR OF MUSIC LITURGY INTRODUCING OUR ENSEMBLES: THE TRADITIONAL CHOIR

Dear Parish Community,

As we reflect on the gift of sacred music in the life of our Church, I'm pleased to begin a new series of articles that highlight each of our parish ensembles. These groups are more than just choirs; they are communities of prayerful musicians who serve week after week, helping to lift our hearts to God through song.

The Family of the Most Holy Eucharist is blessed with a vibrant tapestry of musical ensembles, each contributing uniquely to the liturgical life of our parishes. The Traditional choirs offer classic choral repertoire for weekly liturgies and major celebrations. The Eucharistic Schola Cantorum, a professional ensemble, provides sacred music for First Fridays, Vespers, and solemn feasts. Contemporary Ensembles at Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Antoninus bring modern praise and worship to their Sunday Masses. And our Handbell Choir adds a distinctive sound to special liturgies throughout the year.

Whether you're an experienced singer, a skilled instrumentalist, or someone simply moved by the beauty of sacred music, there is a place for you in our music ministry. Over the coming weeks, I hope this series helps you get to know each group more deeply, and perhaps even find one that speaks to your gifts.

We begin this series with the **Traditional Choir**, an ensemble dedicated to the beauty of choral sacred music.

The Traditional Choir 11:00 a.m. Mass at St. Catharine of Siena | Rehearsals: Thursdays, 7:30-9:00 p.m.

The Traditional Choir leads music at the 11:00 a.m. Sunday Mass at St. Catharine of Siena from September through June. This volunteer choir sings a broad and beautiful range of repertoire, from ancient Gregorian chant and Renaissance motets to beloved hymnody and modern sacred works.

The ensemble rehearses weekly on Thursday evenings, and is known not only for its musical commitment, but also for the warm fellowship among its members. Throughout the year, the Traditional Choir also participates in First Friday Masses and special feast days alongside other parish ensembles.

If you have a love for traditional sacred music, this is a wonderful place to explore that calling. Reading music is helpful but not required; we welcome singers of all experience levels who are willing to learn, grow, and sing with joy.

Our first rehearsal of the new season is Thursday, September 11th, and we would love for you to join us.

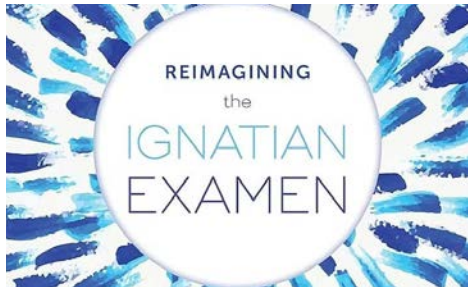
