THE SACRAMENTS

Christ instituted the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation, Eucharist, the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony. The seven sacraments touch all the stages and important moments of Christian life. Please find below information on obtaining the sacraments.

BAPTISM: Expectant parents are asked to call the Evangelization office approximately three months before the anticipated birth date to enroll in the parental preparation program. An inquiry form is available on the fmhe.org website under fmhe.org/Baptism. You may also contact Cindy Weidner in the Stewardship & Evangelization office at cweidner@fmhe.org. For any questions about infant or child Baptisms, or Baptismal Preparation Classes, please contact Erin Evans at eevans@fmhe.org.

MATRIMONY: We ask that either the bride or groom be a registered, active parishioner for at least six months before arranging a date for your wedding. To get started in your preparation process, please call the Worship office at least six months before your wedding date. Contact Christy Welsh at Cwelsh@fmhe.org to discuss the marriage preparation process.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: If you are anticipating surgery or have become ill and would like to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact Christy Welsh in the Worship office.

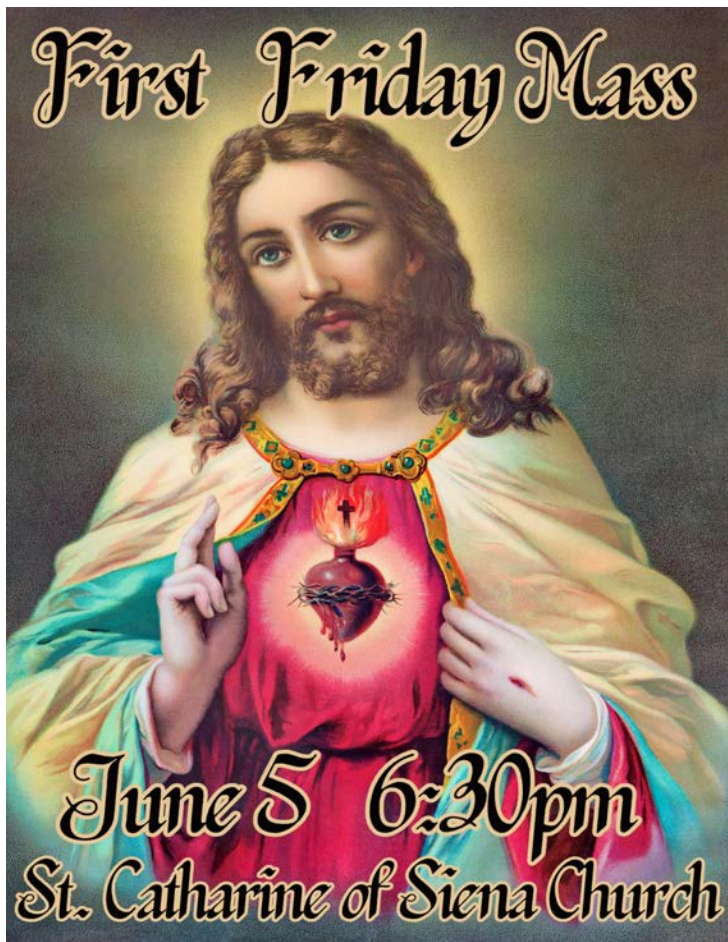

THE INTERNATIONAL PILGRIM VIRGIN STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Coming to St. Antoninus Church on Wednesday, June 10th from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., The International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima – The International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima is a world-famous Marian image that has been traveling since 1947, bringing the message of Fatima to millions who cannot visit the Shrine of Fatima in Portugal.

History and Creation

- **Sculptor & Inspiration:** Created in 1947 by José Thedim, based on the description of Sr. Lucia, one of the three young seers of the 1917 apparitions.
- **Blessing:** On May 13, 1947, in the presence of about 150,000 pilgrims, the statue was blessed by the Bishop of Leiria at Fatima to be “the pilgrim, the traveler.”

Purpose of the Tours: The statue’s mission is to spread Our Lady of Fatima’s message of hope, peace, and salvation, and to offer graces to those who may never make the pilgrimage. Events often include Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, talks, and personal veneration.

Traveling in the U.S.

- The statue has been hosted in parishes across the U.S. under the World Apostolate of Fatima and the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue Foundation.
- Tours have visited over 100 dioceses in 50 states, sometimes in custom trailers or special processions.
- Hosts can request a stop by contacting the organizing foundation or local parish.

Message of Fatima: Our Lady of Fatima’s message calls for:

- Prayer and penance to avoid moral evils and war.
- The Peace Plan from Heaven: daily reparation for sin, Rosary devotion, consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and wearing the Brown Scapular.
- Converting the world to the Catholic faith and saving souls from hell.

There will be talks on Fatima and the Travelling Statue by the caretaker. For any questions, contact Mark Braunstein at pmbsteen@yahoo.com. There is a continuing Fatima Prayer Group since 1994, every Monday evening at 7:00 p.m. in St. Antoninus Church; all are invited to attend.

Hello, my name is Addyson Gruber, I am 16 years old, and a sophomore at Seton High School. On June 14th, from 12:00-3:00 p.m. in the St. Antoninus Church undercroft, I will be holding my 8th annual fundraiser for something very near and dear to my heart. I will be raising funds for all those, including my brother, who suffer from LGS and Dravet Syndrome, both lifelong, catastrophic forms of epilepsy.

As some of you may know, my brother, Braxtin, is 13 years old and has been struggling for more than half of his life with both of these forms of epilepsy. At the young age of 2 1/2, he started having seizures and many other critical health issues which lead to a diagnosis of Dravet Syndrome which then lead to another diagnosis of LGS. People who suffer from these forms of epilepsy also suffer from many other comorbidities like cognitive delays, speech issues, social-emotional issues, behavioral issues, sleep issues and feeding issues just to name a few.

I have watched Braxtin experience all of these issues and more and I want to continue doing everything and anything I can to help him and all those who suffer with these forms of epilepsy. I watch him take several meds, at a minimum three times a day by mouth or his g-tube. I watch him get blood work monthly or sometimes weekly. The number of surgeries, hospital stays and therapy appointments he has had are more than most people will go through in a lifetime. There are also times Braxtin struggles with the simplest of daily tasks. Amazingly though, he never complains.

It's sad to think that so many things we take for granted he will never get to experience. Things like playing sports, driving, living alone, or having a "normal life." I want the best for him and I will continue to fight for him, raise funds, and bring awareness to the struggles he has due to his epilepsy.

Will you help me in my efforts and donate to my fundraiser? We will have basket raffles, split-the-pot, kids games and more! If you can't, please just pray that someday the medical community will understand more about these forms of epilepsy and hopefully find a cure.
