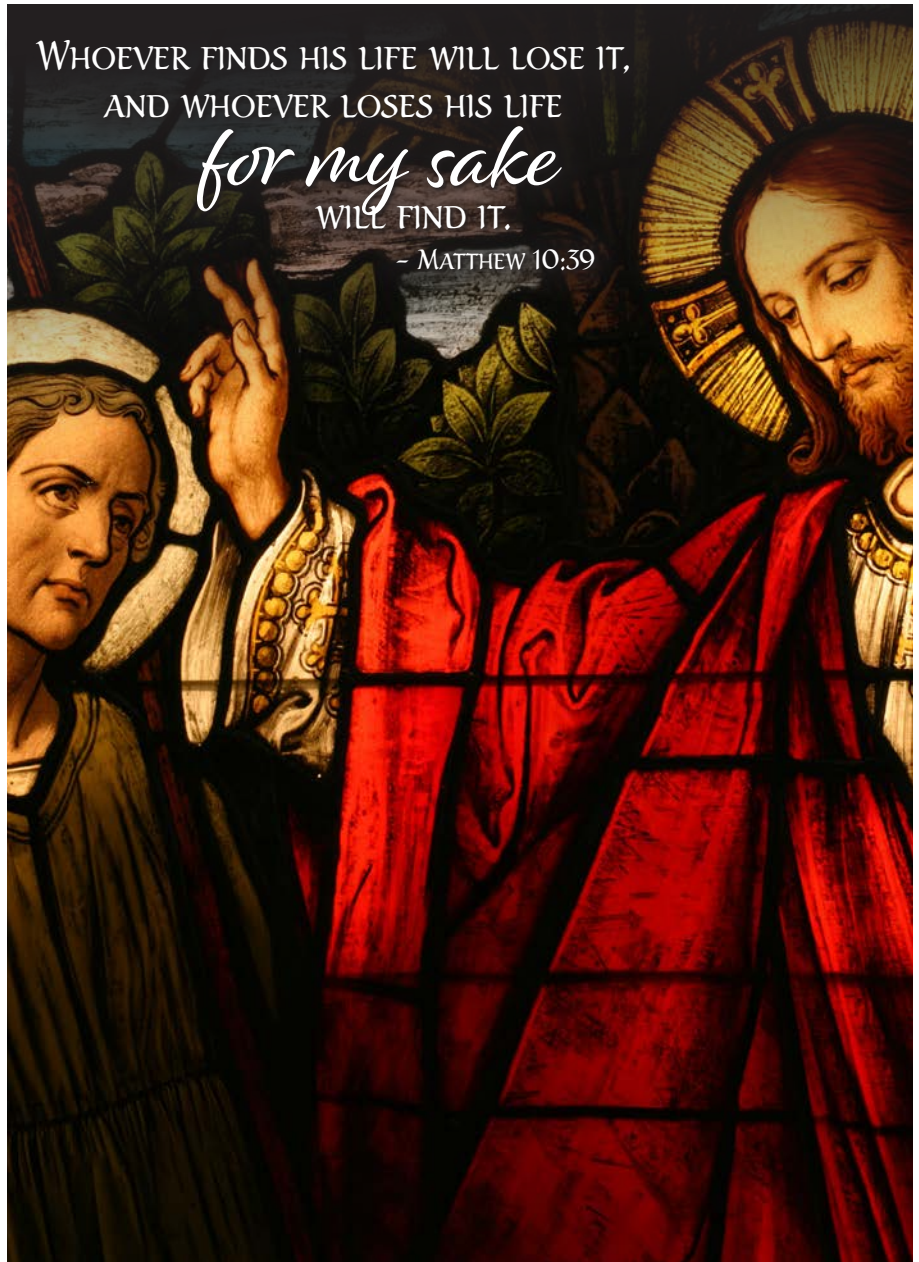

THE SACRAMENTS

Christ instituted the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation, Eucharist, the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony. The seven sacraments touch all the stages and important moments of Christian life. Please find below information on obtaining the sacraments.

BAPTISM: Expectant parents are asked to call the Evangelization office approximately three months before the anticipated birth date to enroll in the parental preparation program. An inquiry form is available on the fmhe.org website under fmhe.org/Baptism. You may also contact Cindy Weidner in the Stewardship & Evangelization office at cweidner@fmhe.org. For any questions about infant or child Baptisms, or Baptismal Preparation Classes, please contact Erin Evans at eevans@fmhe.org.

MATRIMONY: We ask that either the bride or groom be a registered, active parishioner for at least six months before arranging a date for your wedding. To get started in your preparation process, please call the Worship office at least six months before your wedding date. Contact Christy Welsh at Cwelsh@fmhe.org to discuss the marriage preparation process.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: If you are anticipating surgery or have become ill and would like to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact Christy Welsh in the Worship office.

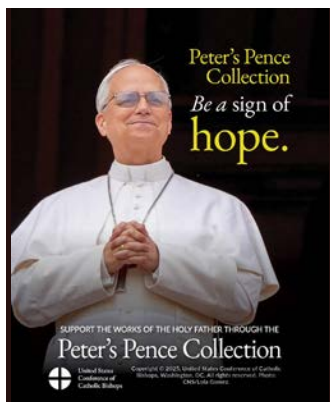

ST. ANTONINUS CHURCH ANNIVERSARY – JUNE 25TH

Brief history on St. Antoninus Parish taken from the Silver Jubilee book:

"The simple declaration by the Archbishop, the Most Reverend John T. McNicholas, which established St. Antoninus Parish on May 27, 1944, was overshadowed by events which took place ten days later. For that day – June 6 – was D-day, the invasion of Normandy by the Allied troops. Twenty-five years later, however, we can look back and appreciate the significance of the creation of St. Antoninus Parish. It has enriched the lives of the Catholic families of Price Hill for a generation."

The church was dedicated on June 25, 1944 and a new pastor was assigned, Fr. Carl F. Goeckeler. The school was not yet built, so the children of parishioners attended the nearby schools of Our Lady of Victory and St. Teresa. The construction of the school could not be realized until after the war was over. When the war ended, thoughts turned toward the building of a school. There was an anonymous donation of \$50 as early as February, 1946, and by July, there was a bank account under the title "St. Antoninus School Fund." On April 13, 1949, the school was completed and dedicated by the Most Reverend George J. Rehring, Auxiliary Bishop of Cincinnati. The parish and school were now established (as well as a convent) and the life of a new parish on the West Side had come to fruition! The "firsts" that took place in the new church were the first Baptism, of Jane Lucia Lentz, on the dedication day of June 25, 1944 and the first wedding was officiated, joining Robert J. Ratterman and Katherine L. Sullivan on Saturday, May 12, 1945. Many societies, groups, and organizations have developed over the years and attest to the spirit and growth of the parish. St. Antoninus has been blessed with the many parishioners – past and present – who have made the parish the phenomenal church that it is today!

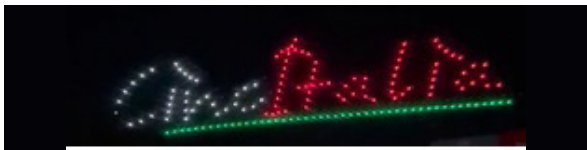
