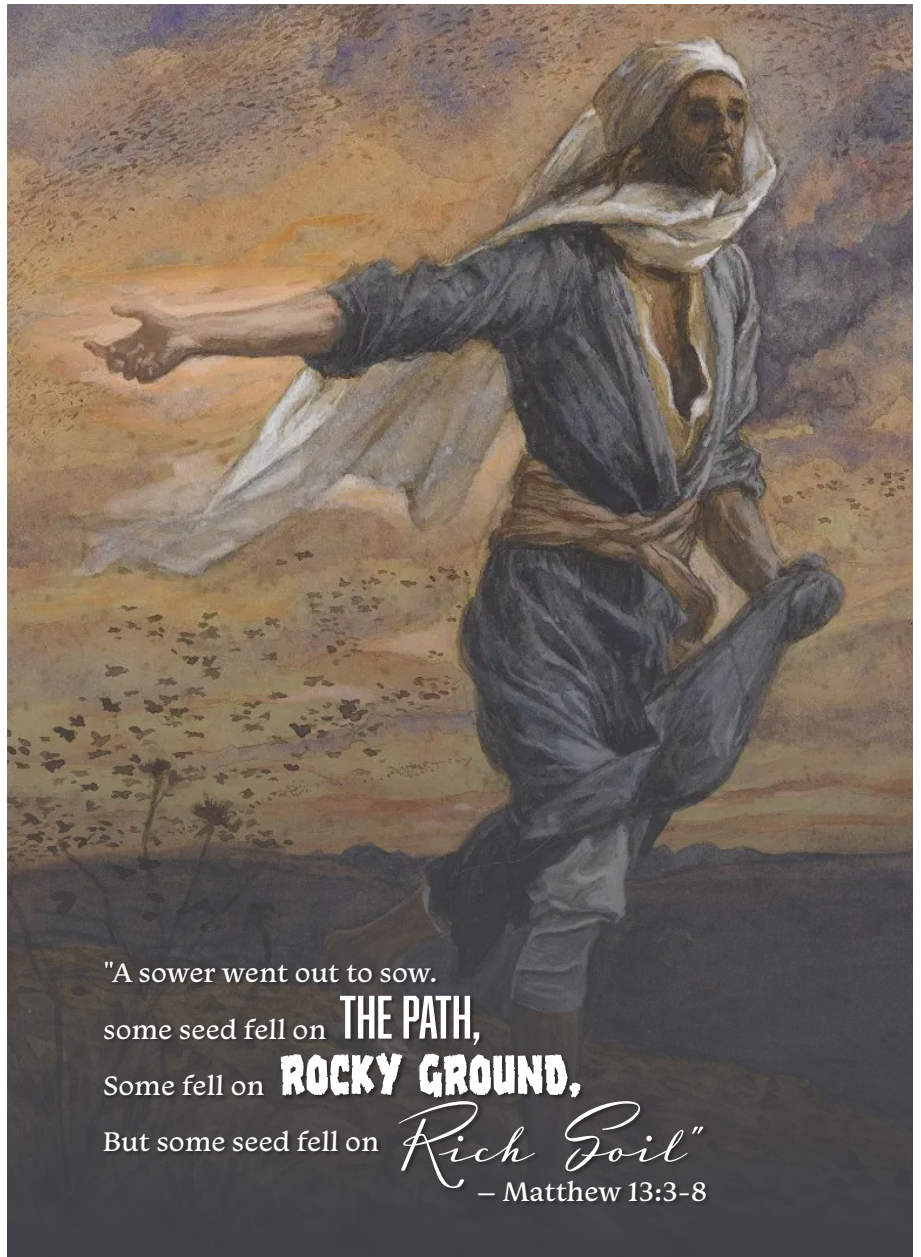

BAPTISM: Expectant parents are asked to call the Evangelization office approximately three months before the anticipated birth date to enroll in the parental preparation program. An inquiry form is available on the fmhe.org website under fmhe.org/Baptism. You may also contact Cindy Weidner in the Stewardship & Evangelization office at cweidner@fmhe.org. For any questions about infant or child Baptisms, or Baptismal Preparation Classes, please contact Erin Evans at eevans@fmhe.org.

MATRIMONY: We ask that either the bride or groom be a registered, active parishioner for at least six months before arranging a date for your wedding. To get started in your preparation process, please call the Worship office at least six months before your wedding date. ANOINTING OF THE SICK: If you are anticipating surgery or have become ill and would like to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact Christy Welsh in the Worship office.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT OFFICE UPDATE FOR YOUR ATTENTION

There are two Safe Environment Office updates relative to background checks that will take effect this summer.

Selection.com has informed the Archdiocese of Cincinnati that, effective July 1, 2026, the fee for the initial online/electronic background check required for all new employees and volunteers will increase from \$25.00 to \$30.00.

The Safe Environment Office of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati continually reviews its procedures to ensure the highest standards of child protection. As part of these ongoing efforts, and in alignment with U.S.C.C.B. recommendations, we are expanding our background check protocols. In addition to the ongoing quarterly updates from the SELECTION.com database, all electronic background checks will now require renewal every five years.

Any individual who is SafeParish trained and has a background check older than five years will need to renew their background check. In the coming weeks/months, those individuals will receive an email from SafeParish with detailed instructions on how to complete the renewal. Please check Spam or Junk folders if you do not receive an email from SafeParish and your electronic background check was completed more than five years ago.

Please note: • A \$20.00 fee will be charged by SELECTION.com. • In some cases, additional county clerk fees may apply. We appreciate your continued commitment to creating a safe environment for all. If you have any questions, please contact your local safe environment coordinator.

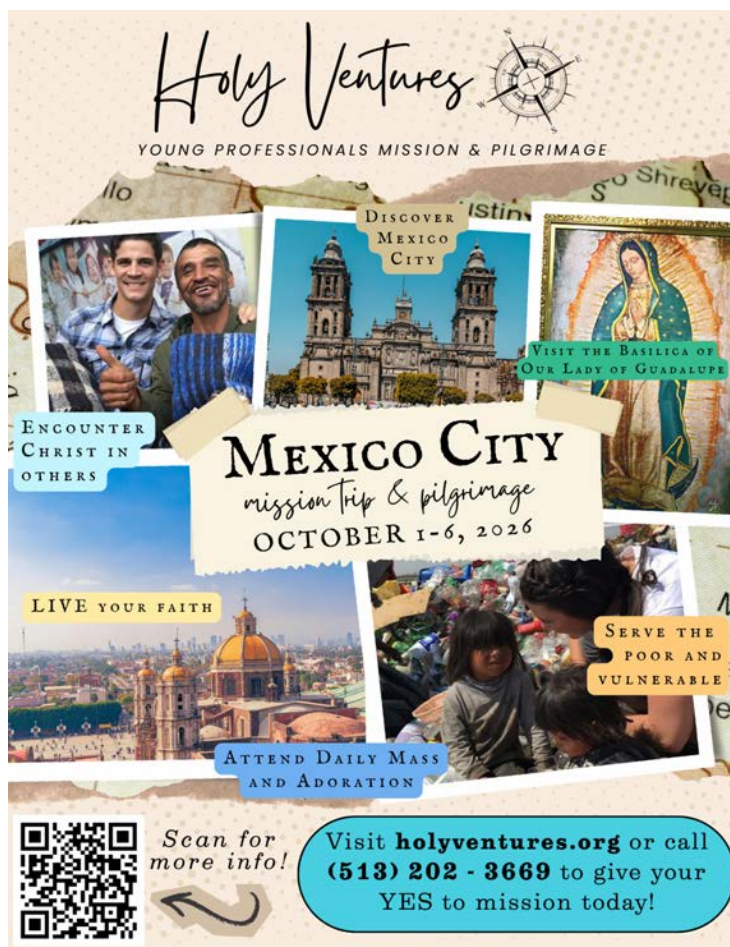

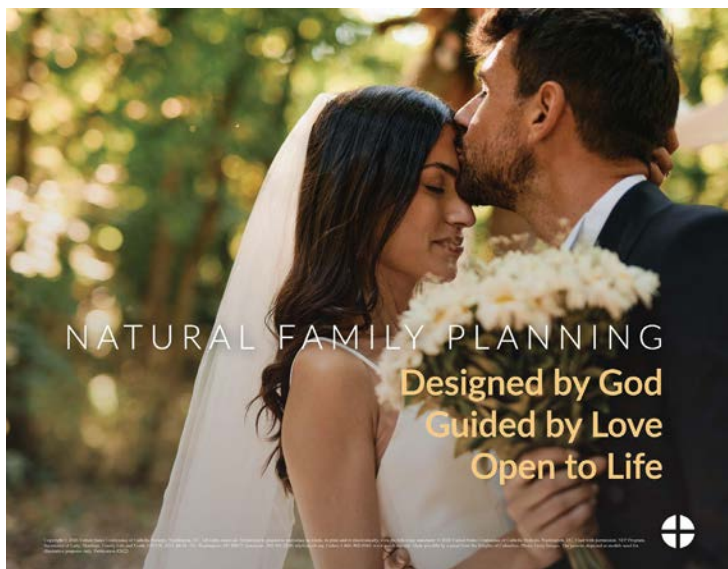

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MASS FOR THE SICK, FOLLOWED BY THE INTRODUCTION/LAUNCH OF THE APOSTOLATE OF THE ROSARY AND MANTLE OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN OF GUADALUPE

On Wednesday, July 22nd at 7:00 p.m., a Mass for the Sick will be celebrated at St. Francis de Sales (1600 Madison Road, Cincinnati, OH 45206), followed by an opportunity to take part in the launch of The Apostolate of the Rosary and Mantle of the Blessed Virgin of Guadalupe.

This apostolate began in Mexico and has spread across the world. Dr. Elizabeth Correa-Mayer, who was a longtime parishioner at St. Philip and currently attends St. Susanna, is the custodian of one of the many hundreds of these mantles, which was blessed by a priest during a Mass in Mexico. Currently this is the only such mantle in Ohio. The mantle is approved by the Universal Church and is considered a sacramental. Many miracles (including profound conversions) have been associated with praying the Rosary while the person being prayed for sits with the mantle draped around him/her and looks at a banner of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Please note that this sacramental is not the same as the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, which is administered only by a priest and reserved for Catholics experiencing serious illnesses, upcoming major surgeries, or are weighed down by the burdens of advanced age. All are welcome to come and pray with us during this Mass for all those who are dealing with sickness of any kind.

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
