On this second Sunday of Advent, we are re-introduced to “the voice of one crying out in the desert,” that is the voice of John the Baptist. Saint John the Baptist is the one who goes about proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, in order to prepare the people for the coming of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. Seeking out the opportunity to have one’s sins forgiven, through the Sacrament of Confession, is a wonderful way to truly prepare your heart for the celebration of Christ’s coming in the flesh, which we celebrate each Christmas. Jesus Himself gave to the Church the gifts of the Sacraments to help us on the pilgrimage to heaven. This is why the Psalmist sings out: “The Lord has done great things for us;

we are filled with joy!” St. Paul explains to the people of how he prays prayers filled with joy for all people, so that they can come to know Jesus in their lives. So, like St. John the Baptist and St. Paul let us never stop proclaiming Jesus Christ to others in all of our words and actions. A reminder that this coming Wednesday, December 8th, is the Holy Day of Obligation celebrating the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, see the bulletin for Mass times.

You do not need to set up an account unless you wish to use this app to follow other parishes.

Search for ‘myParish’ on the App Store or Google Play to download and install this app. This will be labeled “myParish - Catholic Life” from Diocesan Publications.

Once you have it installed, tap on the 3-line symbol in the upper left, tap on “Find a Parish,” enter in the zip code of 58554, scroll through the list to find “Christ the King Church and School” and tap on that. Now you are all set!

Quick tip #1: tap on the square symbol in the upper right to see a bunch of things such as bulletins, news, and more!

Quick tip #2: When finished with a message, swipe the message from right to left than tap Delete.

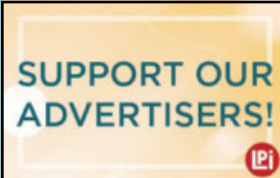
