## Radio show feature **Arab-American views**

In the 1950's, it was "Swing and Sway" to the musical refrains of Sammy Kaye. In the 1990's, radio pumps out more than music, it "rants and raves" to the likes of Howard Stern and WMJI's John Lanigan. On the other hand, Jimmy Kassouf, the "rags to riches" kid says he takes to the airwaves to inform.

He further claims that the pro-Israel lobby controls the U.S. government and therefore, the White House and Congress annually give Israel \$3 billion dollars plus to use as they choose.


Kassouf claims the Israel government uses the no strings attached funds to buy military weapons to control every facet of Lebanese and Palestinian lives.

"I still felt a residue of fear," said Tucker, "even though I loved to fly. It was only after I mastered aerobatics that the fear went away." Tickets are on






