

WHY DO WE WEAR MASKS?

Following is a letter from a parishioner to Fr. Ed that explains why we should wear masks as an act of charity to one another. Six weeks ago after watching Mass on my Ipad at home, I returned to church. I'm a widow, so being with others and having the solace of receiving communion at this time of stress compelled me to return. I've seen you, Fr. Pete, and Fr. Gerry Cunningham remind the congregation re: wearing masks, and why we wear them. The church has done a good job of managing safe distancing in the pews and directions for communion. However, three out of the six weeks I've been back, people sat in the same pew as me without masks. Being a senior, it makes me anxious. I try to get to church early and sit in the middle of the pew knowing I can safely be 6 feet away from anyone coming in later. With the recent increase in cases, my children are advising me to stay home from church. I have neighbors who have told me they have stopped going to St. Tim's for the same reason. I realize this has probably caused a decline in contributions which are so important to continue the mission of the church. I recognize that wearing a mask is not the most comfortable thing for any of us, and I don't know what discretion you have to make this decision, but I implore you to make mask wearing mandatory when attending Mass. It is the least we can do for each other.

The little boy sat straight up, smiling. "Oh, thank you, Mummy!" he yelled. Then reaching under his pillow, he pulled out some crumpled up hills

The woman saw that the boy already had money, she started to get angry again.

The little boy slowly counted out his money, and then looked up at his mother.

"Why do you want more money if you already have some?" the mother grumbled.

"Because I didn't have enough, but now I do," the little boy replied. "Mummy, I have \$20.00 now. Can I buy an hour of your time. Please come home early tomorrow. I would like to have dinner with you." The mother was crushed. She put her arms around her little son, and she begged for his forgiveness.

It's just a short reminder to all of you working so hard in life. We should not let time slip through our fingers without having spent some time with those who really matter to us. Those close to our hearts. Do remember to share that \$20.00 worth of your time with someone you love.

Our prayers are working, as a vaccination for Covid-19 is getting closer to be available for use. Please keep praying for the end of this Pandemic and for all of the health care workers.

CHURCH RE-OPENING INFORMATION

St. Timothy will continue our cautious re-opening of the parish in the coming weeks. We are now open to Ministry Events. This reopening will utilize the following requirements and recommendations:

Required:

- All meetings must be scheduled in advance.
- COVID 19 screening questionnaires must be completed and provided to the meeting leaders prior to the scheduled meeting time.
- Meeting leaders will maintain attendance sheets recording names and contact phone numbers.
- Meeting leaders must enforce Social Distancing.
- No physical contact between meeting participants.
- Refreshments will not be provided.
- After meetings, any participants experiencing COVID 19 symptoms must report this to the meeting leader and parish staff.

Recommended:

- We ask all parishioners to wear a mask as an act of charity to one another.
- When possible, groups should be limited to 10 or less.
- No shared materials or personal items.
- Meeting should be held outside when ever possible.
- Mass and Live Streaming.
 - Mass will be celebrated following our normal Mass schedule.
 - Masses will remain at current ¼ capacity.
 - Mass will be live streamed into the Parish Hall for those who arrive after the numbers become greater than social distancing would allow.
 - Live Streaming of daily Mass on Facebook, Youtube, and on the Parish website at 8:30 AM Monday-Saturday and on Sunday at 9:00 AM will continue.

REOPENING CHURCH

Church is reopened with the regular daily and weekend Mass Schedule.

For those who have concerns about attending weekend Mass at this time:

"The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday is lifted until further notice." – Bishop John Noonan

If you have reservations about coming to church on the weekends, think about coming to daily mass to be able to receive the Blessed Sacrament.

A few items of importance:

- We ask all parishioners to wear a mask as an act of charity to one another. Please remove mask when receiving communion.
- Entry will be through the Main Entrance to the church (off 441/27). Handicap entry is currently closed.
- When the number of parishioners equals the number of persons permitted, remaining parishioners will be directed to the Hall until that fills.
- Holy Water fonts are empty. Health safety restrictions will not allow the use of the sacramental of Holy Water in this way. However, it is most appropriate to continue the gesture of making the sign of the cross upon entering church.
- There will be no basket passed during the collection.
 Baskets will be available at the doors of the church to accept your donations.
- Sign of Peace—it will be appropriate to offer a reverent bow and or verbal greeting.
- Reception of Holy Communion will be in the form of the Sacred Host only and will be received on the hand.
- There will be no Hymnals or Missals available. If you wish to access the information on your phone, that will be acceptable at this time.
- When leaving church, please remember to maintain social distancing. Wave from afar and leave the church property to share fellowship.

SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

"In case of physical or moral impossibility in which a person cannot personally go to confession to a priest, according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the Code of Canon Law, a person is to make an Act of Contrition with a sincere desire to go to confession as soon as it is possible" (CCC 1484; CIC 960).

BELIEVE IN GOD WHO IS TRUTH

How many times have so many of us wished we could talk with Jesus, touch him, speak to him in person? Apparently, Christians earlier centuries had similar thoughts, as Saint John Chrysostom indicates here. even though our five senses are not satisfied with the externals of the Blessed Sacrament, Christ is present just as really now as he was at the Last Supper and on Easter night appearing to the apostles. Stir up your belief in God.

Then, let us believe God in everything, and contradict him in nothing, though what is said seems to be contrary to our thoughts and senses. Rather, let his word be of higher authority than both our thoughts and eyes. Thus let us do with the mysteries also, not looking at the things set before us, but keeping in mind Christ's sayings.

For his word cannot deceive, but our senses are easily beguiled. His word has never failed, but things go wrong with our senses. Since then the word says, "This is my body," let us both be persuaded and believe, and look at it with the eyes of the mind.

How many now say, I would wish to see his form, the mark, his clothes, his shoes. Behold! You see him, you touch him, you eat him. You desire to see his clothes, but he gives himself to you not to see only, but also to touch and eat and receive within you.

Let no one approach the sacraments with indifference, let no one be faint-hearted; rather let everyone have burning hearts, all fervent, all aroused. For if Jews at the first Passover stood, having their shoes on and their staffs in their hands, ate with haste, much more ought you be watchful. For they indeed were to go forth to Palestine, wherefore they had the garb of pilgrims, but you are on your way to heaven.




