In Case You Missed It - The ASA App is Back!

The ASA app is new and improved and ready for you to download to your mobile device. The All Saints Academy GR app is available in the <u>App Store (Apple)</u> and on <u>Google Play (Android)</u>. Search "All Saints Academy GR" and download the app developed by Appazur. By installing the app on your mobile devices, you'll have easy access to all of the information and communication tools most commonly used by parents. The ASA App will provide easy access to:

- Emergency Push Notifications (Be sure to allow them when prompted!)
- School Calendar in either month or agenda view
- Lunch Menu
- Reporting Absences (There's a new form to make this process easier!)
- Staff Contact Information
- Social Media Posts even if you don't have Facebook or Instagram accounts
- School Handbooks
- Parent Links (Blackbaud, Canvas, Infinite Campus, Finalsite, Service Hour Reporting Form, etc.)
- The news feed from the ASA website

Android Users: The old ASA app is still listed in Google Play. Make sure you download the app by Appazur. We're working on getting the old app removed.

Reporting Absences Just Got Easier!

There's a <u>new form for reporting absences</u> included in the new ASA App. This form gives the office staff members all the information they need about your child's late arrivals, absences and early releases, including if your child will be needing school lunch when arriving late. *Please do not email your child's teacher with absence information*, the office staff will take care of that for you. Advent 2023

Advent begins Sunday, December 3. Here is a suggested <u>Advent Calendar</u> to use with your family, with ideas for daily observances. A paper calendar will also be going home this week. ASA will be observing Advent in the following ways:

• In partnership with <u>Community Food Club</u>, our Advent service project will be a cereal drive. The Food Club is seeking donations of cereal to stock our shelves! While we are

routinely able to find all the donated produce we need, the one area lacking is our cereal shelves. It is simply too expensive to stock on a regular basis. The Food Club serves nearly 3,000 youth each month and we all know how kids love cereal! Please consider donating a box or two (or more!) to fill our shelves and provide a staple to Food Club families. All varieties of cereals in regular-sized boxes (no mini boxes) are welcome! Please bring your donations to the Lower or Upper Campus by December 20, and we will deliver them to Community Food Club.

- \$1 Color Days on December 8, 15, 22 with proceeds donated to Community Food Club.
- On the feast of St. Nicholas, December 6, students will receive candy canes and prayer cards.
- Advent prayers and reflections each Monday, including lighting a candle on the Advent wreath, for grades K-2.
- Early Childhood wreath in the hallway with cut outs of green hands, a weekly candle piece per class, and flames from toddler groups.
- At the upper campus, 6th graders will be leading a Jesse Tree reflection every day during morning prayer for grades 3-8.
