Lower Campus Hearing & Vision Screening

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services requires local health departments to conduct hearing and vision screenings for children in Michigan. A hearing & vision technician will screen your child(ren) on February 13th, 14th, or 15th. If your child(ren) are absent on these initial screening days, your child can be screened on our rescreen day March 6th or 7th. Preschool aged children will be screened for hearing and vision. Children in Kindergarten and 2nd grade will have their hearing screened. Children in 1st grade will have their vision screened. If your child has digitally programmable shunts or implanted medical devices, please inform your child's teacher and our office to ensure hearing screening services are not provided.
