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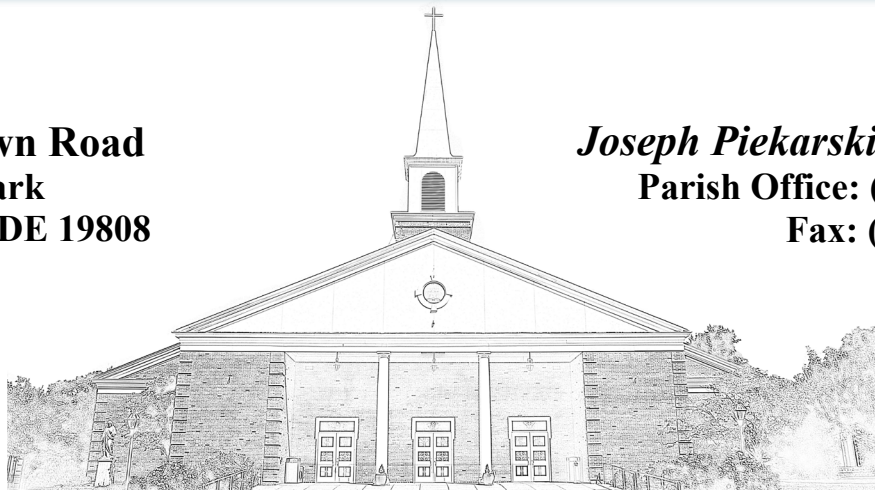

## NOTES FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



The bright month of May reflects the glory of our Blessed Mother in heaven and also the beauty of our natural mothers. As we celebrate Mother's Day, we salute all our mothers who gave us life, nurture us and guide us along the heavenly way. As God's instruments, may they be blessed in their vocation and at last be rewarded with eternal life.

Happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers! We will remember each of you at our Masses this weekend.

Our first reading, this Sunday, explains how deacons were introduced into the Church. The early Church was growing and the Apostles were not enough to keep up with all the demands placed upon them. So they asked for 7 men who could assist the Apostles in hospitality and charity. Saint Stephen was the first to be chosen and was followed by six other men. They were ordained deacons to assist in the mounting duties that the Church encountered with growing numbers.

If only that were the fortune of today's local Church. The Diocese of Wilmington and many neighboring dioceses are facing difficult decisions due to a number of factors, including a shift in Catholic population, declines in Mass attendance and sacramental activity, availability of priests to staff parishes and respond to the needs of its people. To that end, our Diocese has recommended the consolidation of liturgies and ministries within a parish or even within deaneries to safeguard energy, finances and resources.

The Diocesan October Count is a system that tallies the average number of attendees at any given Mass, during the month of October (when the most average numbers take place) in every parish. Saint John the Beloved Parish totaled 9,112 as the number of faithful at all 30 Masses in October 2016. The average weekend count was 1,822 a weekend. The average per 6 weekend Masses was 304. The seating capacity in our church is 800.

After discussion with our parish staff and diocesan officials, it is recommended that we consolidate our weekend Sunday Masses from 6 to 5. Because the 7 p.m. Mass on Saturdays has the lowest attendance (on an average count of 120 and even lower in the summer) of all presently scheduled Masses, at this time we will drop this Mass effective the weekend of the Carnival, June 10th. The other five Masses will remain as they are. Those intentions already scheduled for the 7 p.m. Masses are being moved to an open Mass of the same weekend. Thank you for your understanding.

### Planning Your Final Arrangements:

Memorial Day allows us to remember our beloved dead; those who died in battle and all those who touched our lives. It also reminds us of the need to be prepared for our own passing. The weekend before Memorial Weekend, May 20-21, our parish is sponsoring with our Diocesan Catholic Cemeteries an information program to assist our parishioners and guests in making important final decisions. After all the Masses in the St. John Bosco Room of our hall, representatives from the Diocesan Cemeteries, Health Care Companies, Financial Advisors, Hospice, Funeral Homes, Register of Wills are being made available to us to answer any questions you may have. It is a chance for people to meet vendors and establish points of contact with those they wish. Refreshments will be served. Take advantage of the availability of the many areas that eventually affect us. It is wise to be prepared and prudent to make decisions that suit your desires and lessen the load for those you leave behind.

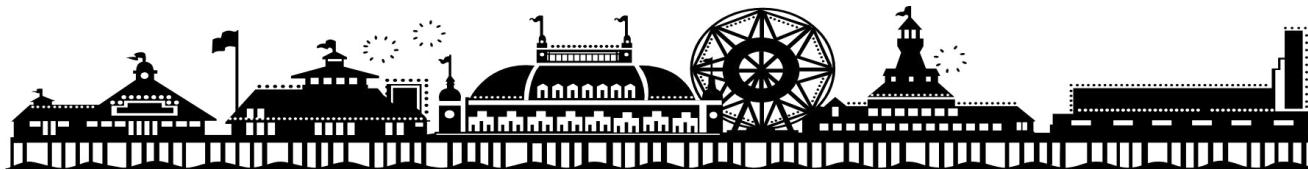
We are most in need of the following items:

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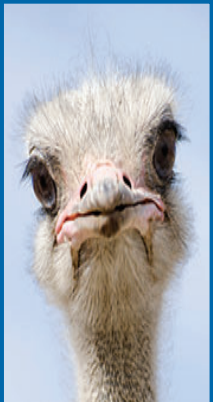
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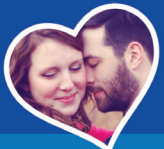
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
