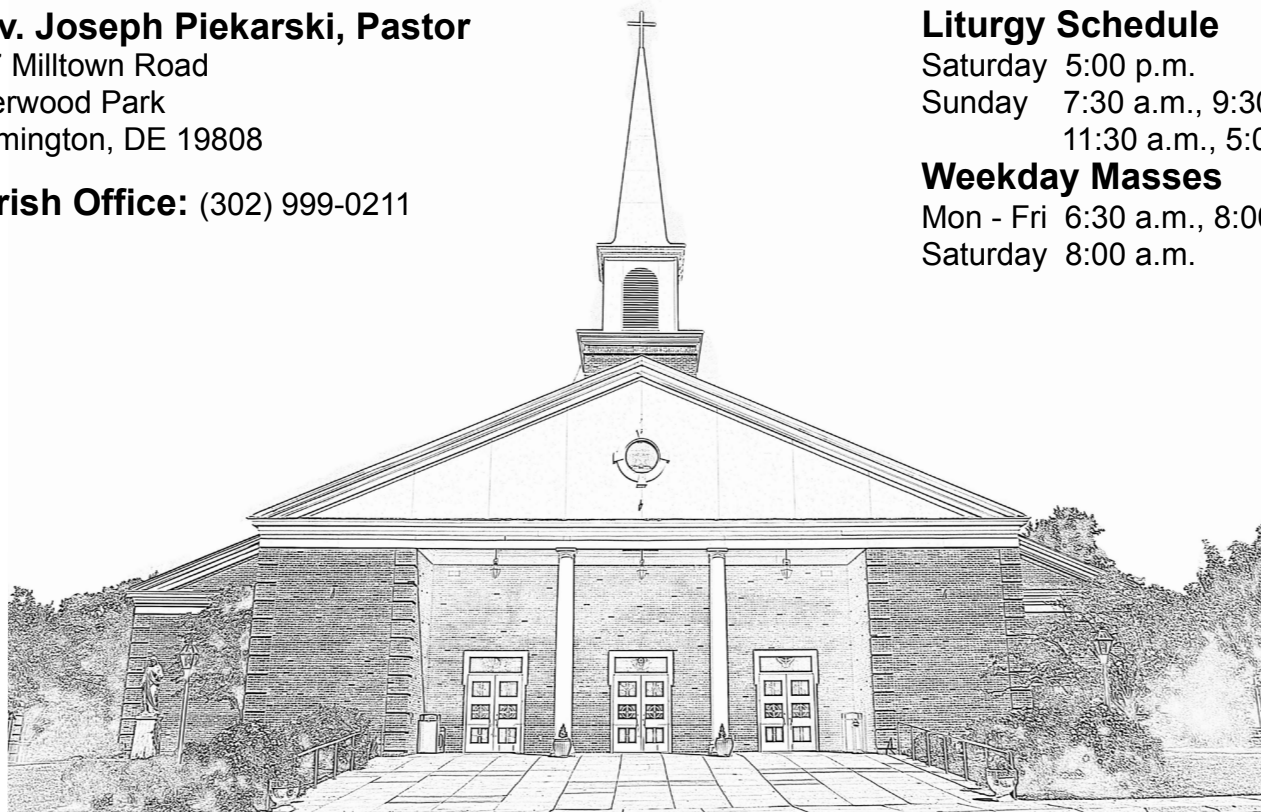

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

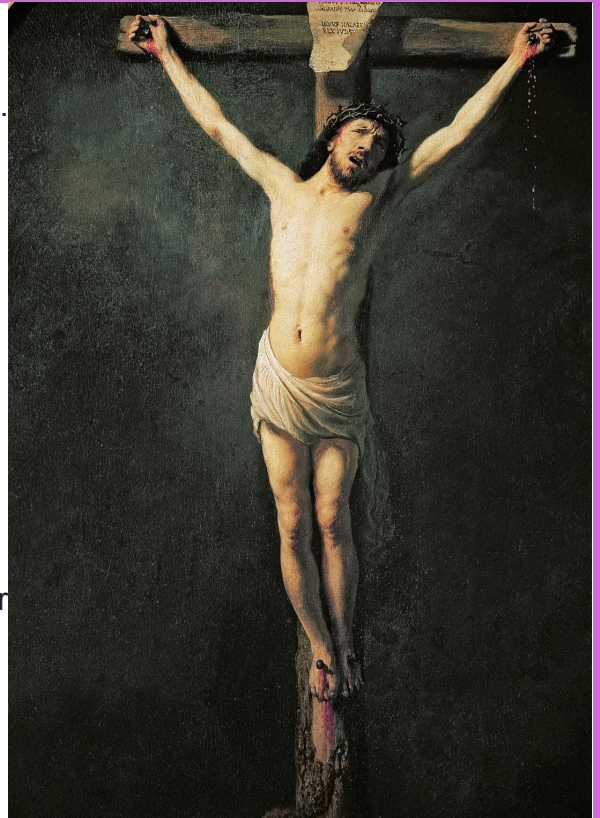
The Fourth Sunday of Lent is called Lætare (Rejoice) Sunday. Rose-colored vestments appear symbolizing the Church's joy in anticipation of the Resurrection of Our Lord. The central theme of today's readings is that our salvation is the free gift of a merciful God, given to us sinners through His Son Jesus. The famous passage: ***"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16)"*** stresses God's mercy and compassion and remind us of the great love, kindness and grace extended to us in Christ.

As Christians, we need to focus on the cross as a forceful reminder of Divine love, and also of the price of our salvation. It encourages us not only to feel deep sorrow for our own sins but also for another's suffering. The crucifix invites us to more generosity and compassion. It inspires us to remove the suffering of other people's misery.

The third discipline of Lent, with that of prayer and fasting, is **Alms Giving**. The Rice Bowl

program is again promoted by the American bishops to help us reach out to those around the world who hunger and thirst. Our parish is fortunate to have outreach programs that help the needy in many ways. The homeless are fed and sheltered by the Family Promise Program. Those in financial and physical crisis are assisted by the St. Vincent de Paul Society. Those with immediate need of food and provisions are provided for by our St. Benedict Outreach Program. Our school and parish groups, like the Knights of Columbus, give sizable contributions to many local and global charities. Needless to say, we do a great deal...and still, there is more to do.

Lent is a good way to focus on the virtue of giving alms to those in need. It is the time to look at the crucified Lord who gave His all that we may live. With such a generous Savior, we cannot help but do the same in modeling His self giving so that others may live.
