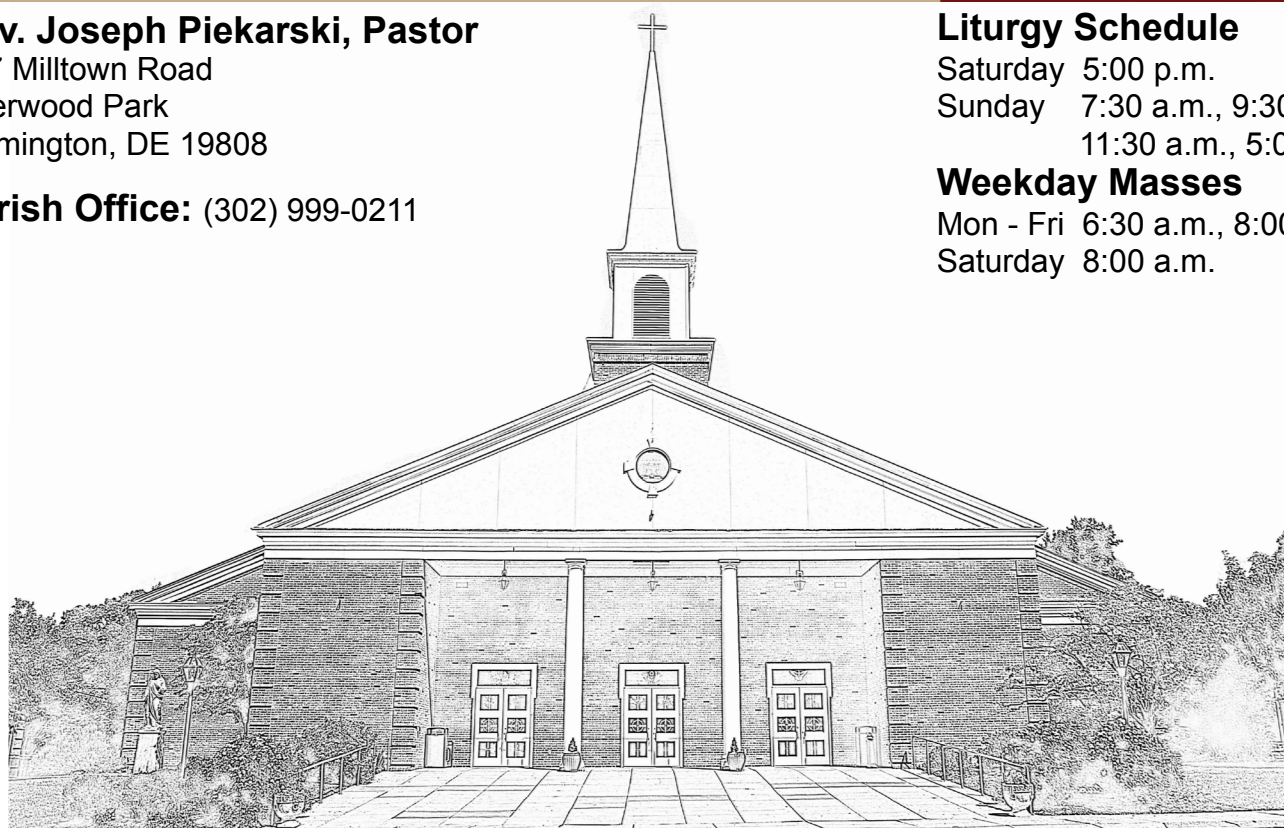

The Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ, together, are called the Paschal Mystery and that is what we celebrate. These coming days are the fulfillment of the Jewish Feast of Passover; a foreshadowing of God's plan of salvation begun by Moses delivering Israel from Pharaoh's slavery. Jesus by His death, burial and resurrection delivered humanity from the tyranny and slavery of sin and death.

What is Tenebrae? It is the service held in our church after the faithful keep vigil at the Repository (the tabernacle that holds the Blessed Sacrament after the Mass of the Lord's Supper) on Holy Thursday. Beginning at 10 p.m., this prayerful service, from the Middle Ages, depicts the "darkness" that overcomes the world when the disciples depart and Jesus enters His Passion. Please feel welcomed to join us in this old, yet new, service that concludes our Holy Thursday.

Please Help! The Easter Sunday Masses are overflowing with visitors. Once the church is full, the overflow must go into the gym/hall. Please be considerate and welcoming of our guests. Remember, a good experience for them, from you, is an invitation to come back. Please cooperate with our ushers who have to oversee the seating, safety and needs of people. If you want a certain seat or need a certain number, make sure you come early. Nobody can reserve seats. Lastly, there are plenty of parking spaces in the back of church, including handicapped spaces. Follow the direction of our parking lot attendants (from our Knights of Columbus). Cooperation from everybody will make it a safe and joyous holy day.

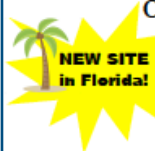

I personally like the RCIA process, as it has helped me learn about the Catholic faith in many different ways and has changed my perspective on who God really is and what he represents.

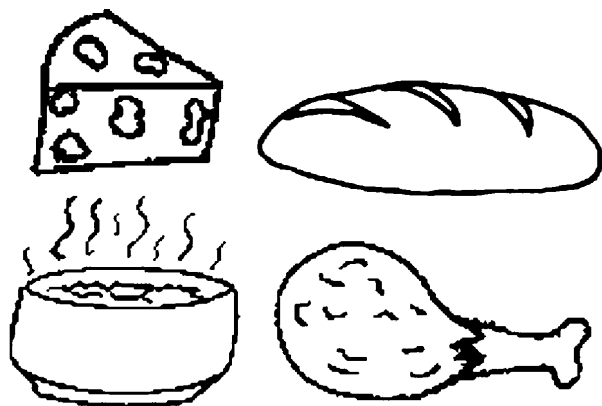

A grain of wheat must die to produce fruit. Jesus was comparing the fact that He must also die so that all might live.

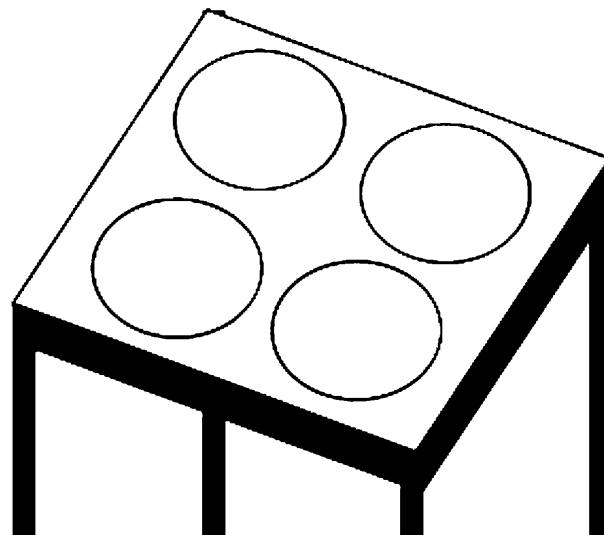
Directions: Circle the foods that could come from wheat.

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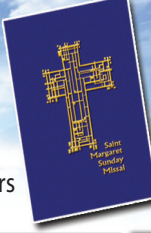
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
