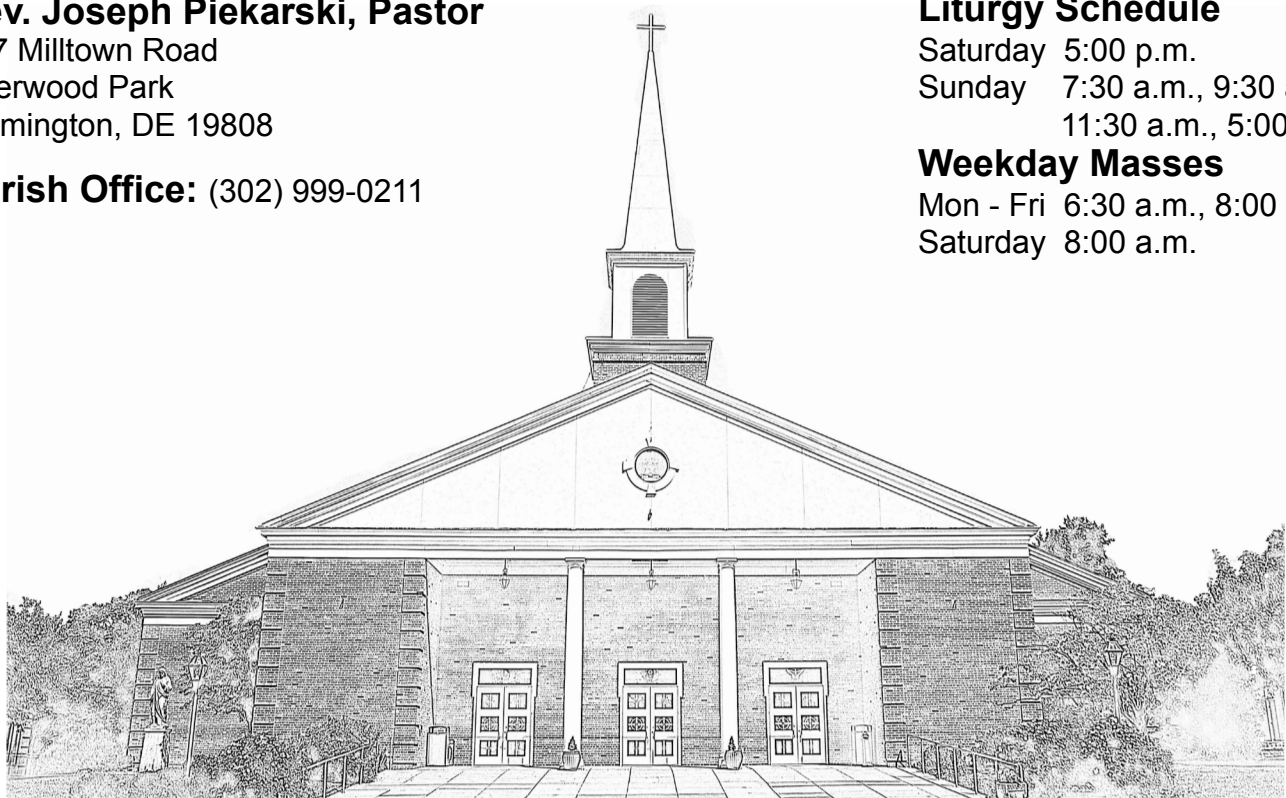

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



This week's scriptures illuminate the identity and mission of a prophet- a calling that belongs to all the baptized by virtue of our Baptism. God appoints the prophets to a specific mission. This mission is to speak God's word of truth.

God's word of truth is not a private or personal opinion, but the Word of God communicated through human words. The prophet speaks God's word of truth to those within and those outside the Church. Prophets do not seek to proclaim a message that is easy to be accepted, but seek to speak God's word of truth, no matter how hard it might be to hear and accept. Christ is the paradigmatic example of the identity and mission of the prophet.

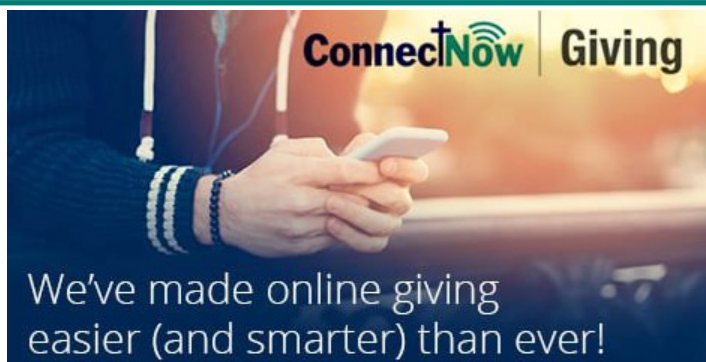

SCHOOL NEWS

THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR will begin with a full day for grades K-8 on Tuesday, September 4, 2018. On the first day of school, students should report to their new grades and the teacher will assign the homeroom at that time. Dismissal time is 2:35 on full days and 11:35 on half days. Start time is 7:35 a.m. with doors opening at 7:20 a.m. First day for Early Childhood children is Thursday, September 6 and it is a full day. The entire school calendar for 2018-2019 is on the website, but subject to change. The school office will be open on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. in July. The office will reopen full-time on Wednesday, August 1, 2018.

Orientation dates for kindergarten are in August and Early Childhood students will be Tuesday, September 4 and Wednesday, September 5, 2018. You will be contacted by the teacher to arrange an appointment for you and your child.

UNIFORM NEWS: Students must either wear the former complete blue uniform or the new black uniform - white plaid for girls and khaki pants for boys. Please do not mix and match between the former and the new uniform.

Catholic Charities taking application for energy assistance

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), administered in Delaware by Catholic Charities, is now taking applications for the 2018-2019 heating season. This federally-funded program assists low-income Delawareans who need help in meeting home energy costs. LIHEAP makes payments directly to home energy suppliers. The LIHEAP benefit is based on a household's income, size, and type of fuel. The application process runs from July to March.

You may be eligible for assistance if your total household income falls within income eligibility guidelines. For example, a household of 4 can have no more than \$50,325 in annual household income (before taxes).

In order to qualify, you must make an appointment with a Catholic Charities office for a personal interview. Regular office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
