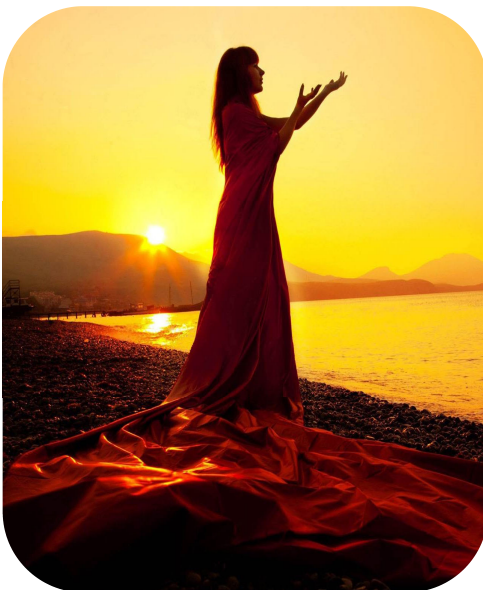

WORSHIP

TO BE A PROPHET

Today's readings show us what it is like to be a prophet. As Jeremiah recounts his call, God warns him that he will need strength and perseverance to withstand the hostility he will face from "Judah's kings and princes" and "its priests and people" (Jeremiah 1:18b). God also assures him that they "will not prevail over you, for I am with you" (1:19). The psalm reflects both of these struggles as well as deliverance from them ("salvation").

This is exactly what Jesus experiences in today's Gospel. After he claims that his own mission is the same as what Isaiah proclaimed, at first the people marvel at his "gracious words" (Luke 4:22). Soon, however, they become suspicious, skeptical, and hostile, even threatening to kill him. But just as God promised to deliver Jeremiah, so Jesus "passed through the midst of them and went away" (4:30).

ADULT EDUCATION

How Well Do You Know Your Faith?

Last week the RCIA catechetical lesson was about The Early Church

Most of what we know about the Early Church comes from the Acts of the Apostles. Acts describes the beginnings of the church in Jerusalem, when they were first called Christians in Antioch, and the missionary journey of the disciples especially Peter and Paul.

The birthday of the church is celebrated on Pentecost. On the first Pentecost, Peter's preaching converted many Jews to become followers of Jesus. The early church was a sect of the Jewish faith because they worship in the temple on the sabbath then would celebrate the "breaking of the bread" on Sunday. They believed that they were living out the fulfillment of the Old Testament's promise of the Messiah and looking forward to his return and his eternal reign.

There were different opinions about what Jesus intended for this church; however, the Holy Spirit was present to guide the Church. During this time, the church began to slowly establish the rituals for the sacraments, teach that salvation was for all people, and the pope's authority to settle disputes. Many of the rites of the early church are still important today – proclaiming the Gospel, practicing the sacraments, and being Christ's witness to the world.

Stephen, the first Christian martyr, was stoned to death because he emphasized the worship of God in spirit and truth over Temple worship. This was the beginning of the Jewish persecution which forced Jesus' followers to leave Jerusalem and to being spreading the gospel to the known world. Christianity began to slowly spread and grow in numbers throughout the world. Christians were able to live in peace until the Roman persecution of the Christians began during the reign of Nero who blamed them for the burning of Rome. There were times when the early church was free of persecution. Christians were believed to be disloyal to the Empire since they did not worship the Roman gods or the emperor as a god. Christians were blamed whenever a catastrophe occurred which led to their persecution. Even as the persecution continues the church grew, the blood of the martyrs were the seeds of growth for the early church because many people were baptized after seeing the Christians willing to die for their faith.

In 312, Constantine had his soldiers place a cross on their shields and he won the battle against his rival thus becoming the Emperor. He credited Jesus for this success. In 313, the persecution finally ended when Emperor Constantine issued the Edit of Milan granting religious tolerance to Christians, allowing them to worship and evangelize openly.

Can you explain why Pentecost is the birthday of the Church to a friend?
