



## **CAMINO DE SANTIAGO PILGRIMAGE 2026**

### Important Terms & Disclosures:

- St. Paul the Apostle Parish (the Parish) is engaging the company Pilgrim Paths for facilitating and support of the pilgrimage.
- Confirmation of registration will be sent by email to each pilgrim.
- Any costs incurred outside of the pilgrimage itinerary are the full responsibility of the pilgrim, including medical assistance, or if a pilgrim is unable to continue the journey at any point.
- Passports and Visas: pilgrims must carry with them a valid passport with the necessary visas if needed by law. Any information from the Parish or any company engaged for this trip regarding any visa applications is only a guideline. The pilgrims are responsible for all necessary visas and legal documentations, noting that European Union (Schengen) visa requirements may vary depending on the country of origin or immigration status of the pilgrim.
- Cancellations and refunds:
  1. The first \$300 paid to the Parish is non-refundable,
  2. The first \$500 paid to Pilgrim Paths is non-refundable,
  3. The cost of the airline & bus tickets is non-refundable,
  4. If a pilgrim cancels 90 days or more before departure, all payments will be refunded except those listed above in 1, 2 and 3. If the cancellation is made fewer than 90 days before departure, all funds are non-refundable.

Release and Assumption of Risk: you understand and agree that during the pilgrimage in which you are participating, under the arrangements of the Parish and Pilgrim Paths, certain risks and dangers may arise, including, but not limited to, acts of God, the hazards of the forces of nature (including but not limited to animal or insect bites), dangers and risks inherent in trekking activities (including but not limited to falls or injuries), changes in health regulations, and accident or illness in remote places without access to medical facilities, transportation, medical professionals, or means of rapid evacuation and assistance. The Parish and Pilgrim Paths shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses caused to any pilgrim in connection with any of the above, mechanical or construction failures or difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, abnormal conditions or developments, or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside the travel company's control. Pilgrims assume complete and full responsibility for, and hereby release the Parish and Pilgrim Paths from any duty of, and all safety or security conditions at such destinations. In consideration of, and as a part of the payment for, the right to participate in the pilgrimage including treks, tours, expeditions, or other activities and as a part of the payment for, the services arranged for you by the Parish, Pilgrim Paths and its agents, employees, associates, affiliated companies, or subcontractors, you do hereby expressly assume all of the above risks.
