

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Wisdom 6:12-16

Regarded as personifying God's power, Wisdom is readily and easily found by those who seek her.

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

The Thessalonians, who fear that those who have died will miss Christ's return, are comforted by Paul's assurance that those "who have died in Christ will rise first."

Gospel: Matthew 25:1-13

In the parable of the five sensible bridesmaids and the five foolish bridesmaids, Jesus emphasizes the fact that we must always be ready for the coming of Christ because in his words, "You know not the day or the hour."

Consider & Reflect

"Then the door was locked. Afterwards the other virgins came and said, 'Lord, Lord, open the door for us.' But he said in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, I do not know you. Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour.'"

During this month when we celebrate the saints and commemorate the holy souls, it is time for us to look at our own spiritual lives and our journey. We often 'put off until tomorrow,' what should be done today. How true that we listen closely to the parable of Jesus and apply it to our own lives, where we stand at this precise moment. When we remember the past we express our gratitude and also ask forgiveness. Yesterday is over. Tomorrow may never come for some of us, so don't wait.

We live in the present 'and if we believe that Jesus died and rose, so too will God through Jesus bring with Him those who have fallen asleep.' May we answer the question 'am I ready now?'





Reflections on the Eucharist

(From The Beauty of the Eucharist: Voices of Church Fathers)

St Ignatius of Antioch thought there was little difference between Jesus' presence in forms of bread and wine and His historical body and blood. He looked on the Eucharist as a "continuation of Christ's incarnational and redemptive activity on earth," since he thought the Eucharist preserves the Church's unity and offers to those receiving it the hope of eternal salvation. He referred to the Eucharist as the "medicine of immortality" and the "antidote which wards off death but yields continuous life in union with Jesus Christ." For Ignatius, the Eucharist is God's gift of His Son to humanity in the form of bread and wine. Those who eat and drink it participate in Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection, and, by allowing Jesus' actual flesh and blood to flow through their veins, become witnesses or martyrs to His cause.

Please watch the bulletin for reflections on the Eucharist each week.



Our lives are transformed through frequent contact with the Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament. It is impossible to spend

extended periods of time with Christ, adoring him, thanking him and uniting our wills to his, and not have him change our lives.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is held on **Fridays** in the Daily Chapel following the 8:00 AM Mass and closing with Evening Prayer and Benediction at **6:00 PM**.
