#### WE PRAY FOR VOCATIONS

Lord of Harvest, we petition you as you have instructed us to ask for more laborers to serve in the vineyard of Your Church. THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are held the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

#### **THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:**

Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

#### THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. "Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."130

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

#### OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

#### **First Reading: Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17**

This passage beautifully describes how the Lord God, as shepherd, will tend his flock. He will rescue those who are lost, bring back those who stray, heal the sick, and "pasture" all.

#### Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28

Paul once again stresses the significance of Christ's resurrection in the total divine plan, emphasizing that Christ's rising means that those who believe in him will also rise after death. Christianity, he argues, is meaningless if it concerns only this life on earth. In the end, even death will be destroyed, and "God will be all in all."

#### Gospel: Matthew 25:31-46

With words both poetic and vivid, Jesus tells the disciples that since he is present in all people, whatever they do to "one of my least brothers" they do to him; and whatever they fail to do to his "least," they fail to do to him.

#### **Consider & Reflect**

"I myself will pasture my sheep; I myself will give them rest, says the Lord God. The lost I will seek out, the strayed I will bring back, the injured I will bind up, the sick I will heal, but the sleek and the strong I will destroy, shepherding them rightly.... 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me.'"

We bring the church year to a close with the appropriate gospel judgement scene. We will all, each and every one, meet our just judge, where our every deed will be exposed and evaluated. A recently published book told the story of a priest who met a person, who said that he felt quite comfortable, as he kept the Ten Commandments. The priest then asked about his concern for Matthew 25, the judgement statement 'I was hungry, thirsty, naked, an immigrant or foreigner, sick...' the corporal works of mercy. As we live them we are going to be judged, not just the Ten Commandments or the great commandment of Jesus to love God and neighbor. The man replied that he hadn't thought about that. Do I?

# ST. THERESA FOOD PANTRY The Food Pantry Needs Some Volunteers

St. Theresa's Food Pantry needs a few volunteers to make the donation pick-ups at local

supermarkets. (Acme - LEH, Manahawkin, Walmart, ALDI)

The amount of clients who are coming to the pantry during this difficult time has grown considerably. In October, the pantry provided food to **491 families** which consisted of **1,124 Adults** and **357 children.** The pantry was open 13 days in October.

The donations, which are picked up from the local stores on a regular schedule, provide food items that we would otherwise have to purchase.

FYI: This activity requires that you are able to drive an extended van (CDL not required), lift and put away the donations. The pickups are made on a regular schedule.

#### **Reflections on the Eucharist**

### From the Catechism of the Catholic Church 1362, 1365

The Eucharist is the memorial of Christ's Passover, the making present and the sacramental offering of his unique sacrifice, in the liturgy of the Church which is His Body....Because it is the memorial of Christ's Passover, the Eucharist is also a sacrifice. The sacrificial character of the Eucharist is manifested in the very words of institution: "This is my Body which is given for you" and "This cup which is poured out for you is the New Covenant in my Blood" (Luke 22:19-20). In the Eucharist, Christ gives us the very Body which He gave up for us on the cross, the very Blood which He "poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins". 




