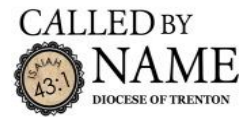

WE PRAY FOR VOCATIONS

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19

This powerful story describes Samuel, who at the time was the servant of the high priest. The Lord called out to Samuel, who twice thought Eli had called him. They gradually realized that it was the Lord who called for him. So the third time Samuel answered and the Lord remained with Samuel as he grew.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20

Paul explains to the Corinthians that their body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. He tells them to avoid lewd conduct, and glorify God by keeping their bodies pure.

Gospel: John 1:35-42

John told two of his disciples that Jesus is the Lamb of God. They turned and followed him, immediately curious and attracted to him. Andrew told his brother Simon about Jesus. Simon also came to meet Jesus, who renamed Him Cephas, or Peter.

Consider & Reflect

“John was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by he said: ‘Behold the Lamb of God.’ The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following Him and He said to them, ‘What are you looking for?’ They said to Him ‘Rabbi... where are you staying?’ He said them, ‘Come and you will see.’”

We picture this meeting, we hear the conversation, and Jesus asks us the same question, ‘what are YOU looking for?’ Take time to answer, for we are asking Him to come to us and accompany us on our journey as His disciples. It was Andrew who informed Peter and brought him to Jesus. Jesus had a special job for him. Every disciple of the Lord is another Andrew. To whom can I speak and invite to know Jesus?

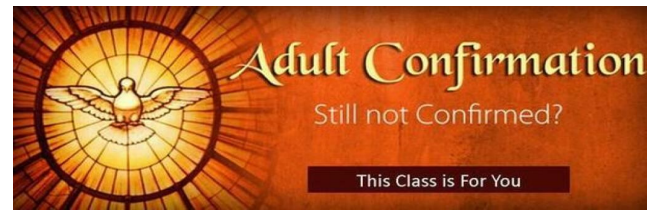

Hand Washing

Washing your hands is probably your best defense against getting a cold, virus or other infection. Hand washing helps wash away germs that you picked up from people, surfaces or from animals.

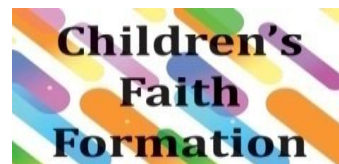

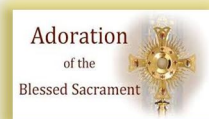

Reflections on the Eucharist

Excerpt from "The Mystical Body of Christ" (pg 209) by Bishop Fulton J. Sheen

"The Church is the great Tree of Life. The secret of her Life is not to be sought in anything external or earthly, thought it has roots in the earth. The real source of its energy is something invisible and spiritual. What the solar energy is to the tree, the Eucharist is to the Mystical Body (the Church); what the leaf is to the tree, that is what each individual Catholic is to the Church. As each leaf draws force from the great invisible solar energy, so does each Catholic draw life through Communion with Divinity in the Eucharist. Without the sun, the tree could not live; without the Eucharist, the Church could not live. The more Catholic leaves there are on the tree of Life or the Church, the greater her strength and her unity. As the tree is one though made up of a multiplicity of leaves because all are nourished by the same sun, so the Mystical Body is one though made up of many Catholics because all are nourished by the same Eucharist. Such is the secret of Catholic unity – the communion of man with God."
