THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Deuteronomy 18:15-20

Moses explains to the people that a prophet will come from among them, and that they should listen to this prophet's words, for God has told him of this prophet. God also tells Moses that anyone who pretends to speak in his words, or speaks in the name of other gods, shall die.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 7:32-35

Paul tells the Corinthians how an unmarried man or woman is able to devote themselves fully to God without concern for the needs of a spouse. Paul explains that God wants to help them promote good and devote themselves more fully to God.

Gospel: Mark 1:21-28

As Jesus was teaching, a man with an unclean spirit came to the synagogue and asked if Jesus had come to destroy them. Jesus ordered the spirit out of the man, who shrieked violently as the spirit departed. The people were amazed at the authority He had over the spirit.

Consider & Reflect

"A prophet like me will the Lord God raise up for you, from among your own kin, to him you shall listen... I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their kin, and will put my words into their mouth, he shall tell them all that I command him. Whoever will not listen to my words which he speaks in my name, I myself will make him answer for it."

The first pages of scripture tell us of a promised redeemer. The prophets, the spokespersons for God constantly reminded the people of their covenant with God. John the Baptist pointed out Jesus as the one. Jesus being present made a new covenant, and today that covenant is renewed in His church.

Promise, prophets, presence, preaching, the story of salvation for us all. Today we are called to listen to the voice of God found in the teaching and preaching of our church leaders, chosen ones, who are calling us to awaken and respond to the covenant God made with us. We hear the word proclaimed at mass, we open the bible at home to reflect upon it. We have so many resources on YouTube or Relevant Radio to continue to form and reform our lives. May this help us answer His call.

Reflections on the Eucharist

Excerpt from, “Mystery of the Altar: Daily Meditations on the Eucharist”, Kenneth J. Howell & Joseph Crownwood quoting Bl Rabanus Maurus (c. 780 – 856) pg. 36

“The Flesh of Christ is the true food that He feeds us, which nourishes man unto everlasting life, and His Blood is the true drink, which eternally satisfies those who hunger and thirst in their souls for justice. While it is possible to have earthly life without food and drink, eternal life is absolutely not possible. For this Food and Drink signify the Head and Source of the members of the eternal communion. He (Jesus) says, “He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in Me and I in him.” (John 6: 56). Wherefore, it is necessary for us to receive His Body and Blood, and remain in Him as members of His Body *since no one has ascended to heaven except He who descended from heaven, the Son of Man, who is in heaven.*” (John 3:13)

My name is Sandi Johnson and I am one of the coordinators of our Family Promise ministry. This past spring we hosted a family for a week and a half as they prepared to be able to live on their own. I am happy to say they succeeded. This upcoming year we will once again host a family or families in our Faith Formation Center (FFC). Part of what we do is to provide a safe place for them to sleep. This entails two members of our church coming to the FFC around 7:00pm, meeting the family and then sleep over in their own room. The family usually leaves around 7:30am at which time you can also leave. Family Promise provides a very comfortable cot and you bring your own sheets, pillow and blanket. We do this for the safety and protection of the family and our FFC. For the privacy of the children, we do not allow anyone under 18 to participate.

To do this, you must take a Virtus course online (or in a group if we have enough people) and be fingerprinted. Our church will pay for the cost of finger printing. We really need a few people to help in this part of our Family Promise Ministry, so please consider helping us. For those that like to prepare meals for the family, don't worry, we will be calling on you to help later this year.

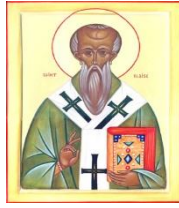
