FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

First Reading: 2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 19-23

The people of Judah practiced many abominations, even polluting God's temple in Jerusalem. They mocked the messengers he sent among them, until he grew so angry he delivered them to the King of the Chaldeans. Those who weren't killed were exiled and became servants for seventy years. Cyrus, King of Persia, was ordered to build a temple to God in Jerusalem, and he freed the servants as God had inspired him to do.

Second Reading: Ephesians 2:4-10

Paul declares that God brought us to life in Jesus, though we had been dead from our sins. He reminds us that it was not a reward for our good service so no one should take credit. Instead, we must remember that it was not our doing, but a sign of God's mercy and love for us.

Gospel: John 3:14-21

God so loved the world, he sent us His only Son so that all who believed would have eternal life in Him. The light came into the world, but those who were wicked avoided it, for fear that their evil deeds would be exposed. But those who believed were unafraid of the light, where it would be clear that their deeds were done in God.

Consider & Reflect

"But the Lord said to Samuel: 'Do not judge from his appearance or from his lofty stature, because I have rejected him. Not as man sees does God see, because man sees the appearance but the Lord looks into the heart."

Remember the prayer of Solomon, asking God for the gift of right judgement? We spend much time judging people, their motives, their gifts and faults. How do we look at ourselves? As we read the book of Samuel as God is preparing for David for His people, we learn that we should judge with the eyes of God, what He sees in us, and not just the appearance.

Lent is our special opportunity to look deep into our heart to see what He sees, and root out what is displeasing, or shouldn't be there. Jesus came to assist us in this task.

Reflections on the Eucharist

From "Beautiful Eucharist, Right Here, Right Now, No Place I'd Rather Be" Bishop Andrew Cozzens, pg. 50

It's important to understand the heart of our Catholic teaching, which is simple, even though it's mysterious...the substance of the bread and wine changes completely through the words of consecration, such that, there's no more bread and wine there. It appears like bread and wine. It has all the properties of bread and wine, but there's no bread and wine there. What is there? Jesus! And He's present so that He can come to you because He wants to be one with you. There's no more intimate way that He could come to you except to come to you as your food, to feed your soul. We need to be clear about that teaching. But it's not just teaching that makes a disciple. What we need is to move the heart experiences where we can encounter Him – adoration, devotions, music, the environment, candle-lit processions. Something beautiful that we're doing that helps us in our hearts because we're embodied persons. When we kneel, bow before Him, sing, all this helps us as embodied persons to experience His presence. That's what changes hearts. Please watch the bulletin each week for reflections on the Eucharist.

My name is Sandi Johnson and I am one of the coordinators of our Family Promise ministry. This past spring we hosted a family for a week and a half as they prepared to be able to live on their own. I am happy to say they succeeded. This upcoming year we will once again host a family or families in our Faith Formation Center (FFC). Part of what we do is to provide a safe place for them to sleep. This entails two members of our church coming to the FFC around 7:00pm, meeting the family and then sleeps over in their own room. The family usually leaves around 7:30am at which time you can also leave. Family Promise provides a very comfortable cot and you bring your own sheets, pillow and blanket. We do this for the safety and protection of the family and our FFC. For the privacy of the children, we do not allow anyone under 18 to participate.

To do this, you must take a Virtus course online (or in a group if we have enough people) and be fingerprinted. Our church will pay for the cost of finger printing. We really need a few people to help in this part of our Family Promise Ministry, so please consider helping us. 
