THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held the first and third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least two months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.



THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is **no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.** A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *“Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived.”¹³⁰* We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail themselves of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.



OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, **KING OF THE UNIVERSE**

First Reading: 2 Samuel 5:1-3

Samuel describes how all the tribes of Israel went to David in Hebron and said they were his bone and his flesh and it was he who led them back to Israel. The Lord told David he would be a shepherd to His people. David made an agreement with the elders and was anointed king.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:12-20

Paul explains to the Colossians that God has made them fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light and that through the Son we have redemption and forgiveness of sin. He describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God, the head of the church and in Him all things hold together.

Gospel: Luke 23:35-43

Jesus is mocked by the crowd as he hung on the cross. Above him was an inscription that read "This is the King of the Jews." One of the men being crucified with Jesus tells Him to save them and Himself, while the other asks that he be remembered when Jesus is in His Kingdom. Jesus said in reply, "Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

Consider & Reflect

"As they approached to offer him wine they called out 'If you are King of the Jews, save yourself'. Above him there was the inscription that read, 'This is the King of the Jews'... 'Jesus remember me when you come into your Kingdom.' He replied to him, 'Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise.'"

From the earliest gospel teaching we heard Jesus speak of the Kingdom. The parables offered us countless examples of what the Kingdom is like. As we stand at the cross on Calvary today, we honor the King and identify as members of His Kingdom. How often people when viewing a crucifix ask, 'what does INRI mean?' The gospel text tells us who it is hanging there in order to save us. Like the repentant thief, we ask that He remember us today, and yearn to hear Him say,

'I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise.'

Food Pantry Volunteers Wanted

St. Theresa's Food Pantry is looking for one or two volunteers who would be interested in performing the following tasks regularly, i.e., one day or more per week, depending on the tasks required:

- 1) Stock the shelves one day a week (Thursday).
- 2) Order food items as needed from local stores or online sources to ensure a variety of food is available for the clients. This includes: placing the order, arranging delivery to the pantry, and stocking the shelves when product(s) are delivered.
- 3) Provide backup as needed for making the scheduled donation pickups at local stores. Donation pickups are made: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday. The ability to drive the food pantry van is required.
- 4) Assist, along with other volunteers to transfer the monthly parish donations from the gathering space to the pantry and put away the monthly food delivery from Fulfill.




