### THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held the first and third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least two months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

### THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

### THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is **no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick**. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *“Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived.”<sup>130</sup>* We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail themselves of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

**Breaking Open the Word**

**First Reading: Isaiah 2:1-5**

The words of Isaiah urge all people to forsake war and to live in peace forever. The tone reaches a climax in the words, *“One nation shall not raise the sword against another, nor shall they train for war again.”*

**Second Reading: Romans 13:11-14**

Paul invites us to put away all the things of darkness and sin and to prepare for the coming of Christ.

**Gospel: Matthew 24:37-44**

A comparison is made between the destruction caused by the flood in Noah's time and the need to be prepared for the second coming of Christ. *“You must be prepared in the same way. The Son of Man is coming at the time you least expect.”*

**Consider & Reflect**

*“You know the hour in which we are living. It is now the hour for you to wake from sleep, for our salvation is closer than when we first accepted the faith. The night is far spent, the day draws near. Let us cast off the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light’... ‘The Son of Man is coming at the time you least expect.”*

Welcome to another new season of Advent. We are looking again for the coming of the Lord, remembering Bethlehem and His promised coming again. Since our last advent, have you ever thought of your final destiny, salvation won for you by the first coming of Christ?

Let's begin this Advent thinking, not about our celebration of the birth of Christ, but His coming at the end of time and our salvation. Am I ready to meet Him? Am I concerned about the salvation of others, my friends, and family? Consider the words of Paul in Romans as he stirs us to wake from sleep and both think and act, as we prepare for His coming. The words of the hymn echo in my heart: *‘Jesus is the Lord of my salvation; I trust in Him and have no fear.’*




