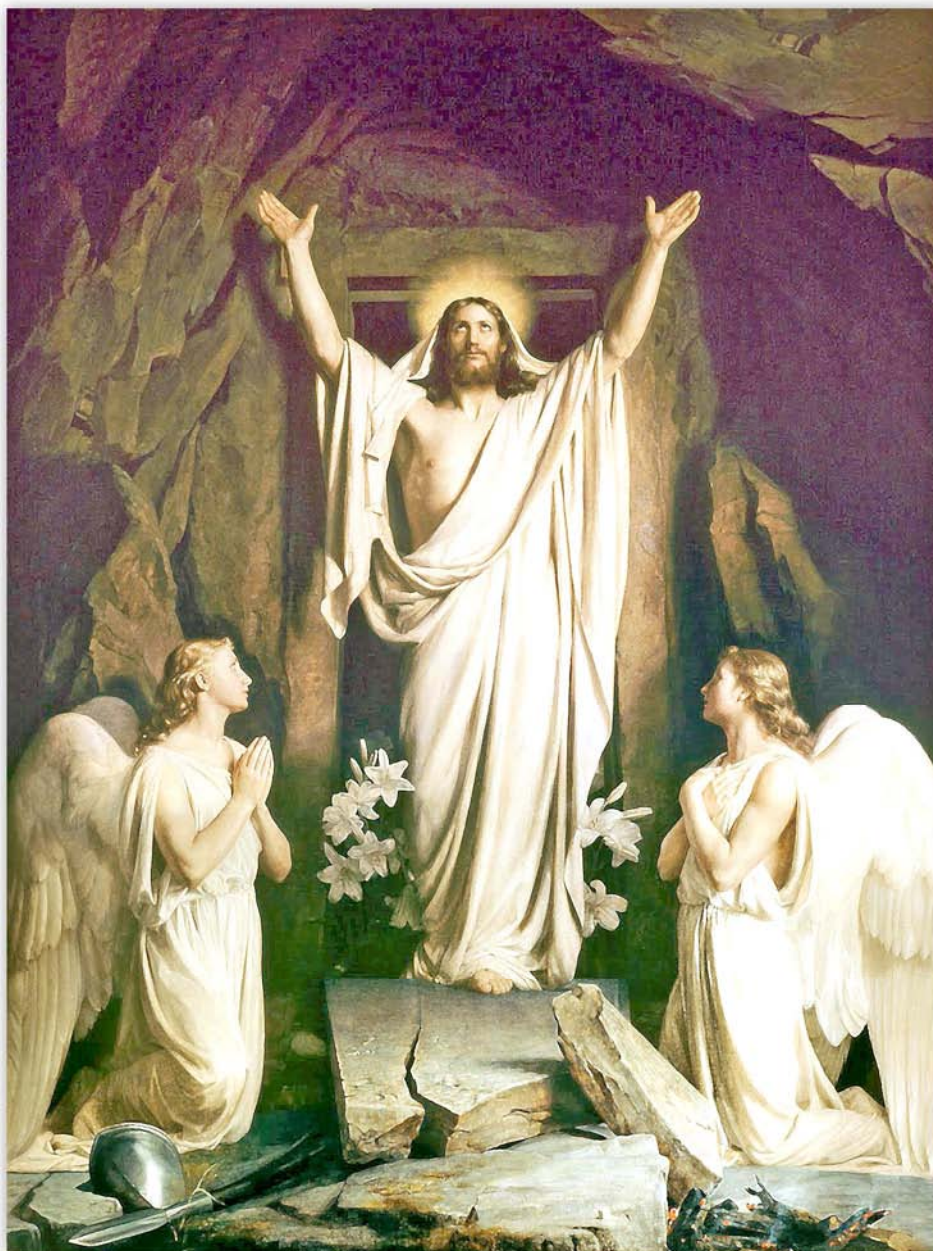

Sunday, April 20

EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION **OF THE LORD**

First Reading: Acts 10:34a, 37-43

Peter discusses Jesus' life of preaching and healing. Jesus was crucified, and then He rose up and was seen by His chosen witnesses. Peter also mentions the importance of all the disciples bearing witness to what they saw, so that many people would believe in Jesus, and have their sins forgiven through Him.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4

Paul asserts that we must pay attention to higher realms rather than earthly concerns. Our life is not yet completely known to us, until Christ appears and we are raised to glory in Him.

Gospel: John 20:1-9

When Mary Magdalene discovered Jesus' tomb was open, she told Simon Peter and another disciple. They ran to the tomb and Peter went inside. He found the burial wrappings on the ground, with the head covering separate from the rest. The other disciple came in and they believed what they saw, although until then they had not understood the Scripture's message of Jesus' resurrection.

Consider & Reflect

“Brothers and sisters: Are you unaware that we who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in the newness of life. Consequently, you too must think of yourselves as being dead to sin and living for God in Christ Jesus.”

Saint Paul provides a summary of what makes us who we are – we are an Easter people. The weeks of Lent, the days of Holy Week have led us to this awesome fact; we are now able to live in ‘the newness of life.’ Recalling the steps leading to this day, we now are summoned to express gratitude, for before this we were dead, alienated from God, but through His saving work everything is different.

The doors of paradise are now opened; the distancing of the then has been replaced by the new closeness of the now, intimacy of God through His grace. Easter is not a day to commemorate, but the beginning of living differently, because He lives and we do too. In one word **‘Alleluia.’**

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

been hosting families by providing shelter and meals for several years, before and after Covid. The parish will be hosting once again this year for the weeks of **May 25th and June 1st**. We have simplified the process of providing breakfast, lunch and dinner to suit their needs, while providing a safe shelter for the families to sleep. In order to meet this challenge, we are asking for donations of gift cards to Walmart, Acme and Dollar Tree and to any of our local restaurants. The gift cards will be used to purchase the items needed while they are with us and the restaurant gift cards can allow the families to enjoy having a meal out at a restaurant or get take out while we are hosting them. If you would like to donate, you can drop them off in an envelope marked Family Promise, to the parish office, any time prior to May 25th. In the past, many of our parishioners have prepared dinner for the families. As we get closer to the dates of our host weeks, we will be contacting those that have prepared dinner for our families and those who have contacted me recently. If you are interested in preparing a meal, please let me know.

Members of our wonderful parish have stayed overnight (in their own room) with the families in our Faith Formation Center. A few more people are needed to stay overnight. It is required by the church, to ensure that the children are safe while they stay with us, that they take an online course called VIRTUS and be finger printed prior to hosting. This will be arranged through St. Theresa Church. For those that have stayed overnight before, please check your card to verify the expiration date, you may have to be recertified. 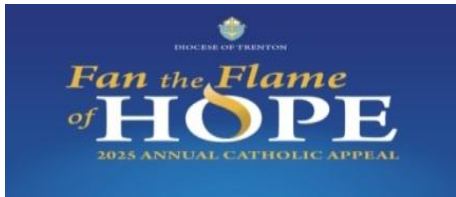

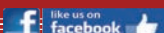
