THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *“Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived.”*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

First Reading: Acts 13:14, 43-52

Paul and Barnabas addressed many people, and large crowds gathered to hear them. Some of the Jews became jealous and argued with whatever Paul said. But Paul and Barnabas continued preaching their message of salvation and everlasting life until they were eventually forced to leave the town.

Second Reading: Revelation 7:9, 14b-17

John saw a vision of many people surrounding a throne and the Lamb. One of the elders told him these were the people who had survived great periods of trial, but maintained strong faith in God. Now they would receive eternal protection and comfort from God as reward for their loyalty.

Gospel: John 10:27-30

Jesus states that His sheep know His voice and follow Him and will receive eternal life. Jesus also says that no one can snatch His followers away, because God is greater than anyone who might try, and Jesus is one with God.

Consider & Reflect

“Jesus said: My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand.” “All who were destined for eternal life came to believe, and the word of the Lord continued to spread.”

Traditionally, the fourth Sunday of Easter is called Good Shepherd Sunday, as the gospel always focuses on Jesus who shepherds us, leading us to eternal life. He has instructed us, stating that *‘eternal life is this, to know the Father and the Son whom He has sent.’* That knowledge is not something reserved for the head, but a knowledge which flows from the heart as well. We are told only eighteen inches separate the head from the heart.

As I live the Easter season, I wish to pursue this life that Jesus, by His dying and rising, gained for me. As the word of God continues to spread today, I am called to bring this message to others. *‘Do I hear His voice speaking to me today?’* Jesus lives!



Ministries and Groups.


The Holy See

Jubilee of Confraternities
May 16 - 18, 2025

Confraternities are Christian voluntary associations,
often coordinated by lay women or lay men to
promote charitable works, devotional life, or a
particular mission in the Church. Well-known
examples include the Society of St. Vincent de Paul,
Knights of Columbus, National Council of Catholic
Women, Catholic Daughters Pilgrims on the Way.
The popular piety at work in confraternities also
constitutes a powerful witness of the spirituality
of the Catholic Church. Continue to share that
spirituality with your families, friends, colleagues, and
neighbors in a way that is inviting and, in so doing,
can offer a hope to those who are seeking God’s
graces in their lives. The Second Vatican Council
called on all the laity to “work for the sanctification of
the world from within as a leaven” (Vatican II, Dogmatic
Constitution Lumen Gentium, no. 31). And when the laity
walk together, they can be a united force of hope in
society, something that is yearned for by both
Catholics and non-Catholics alike. Working side by
side offers a diversity of gifts to be used as a force for
good in the world, transforming it ever closer to the
realization of God’s kingdom.

- **St. Vincent de Paul (1581-1660,** feast day
September 27), patron of charities,
volunteers and hospitals, and co-founder of
the Congregation of the Mission (the Vincentians) and
the Confraternity of Charity. A native of France, Vincent
was a humble, compassionate priest who dedicated
himself to serving the poor.
- **Bl. Michael McGivney (1852-1890,** feast
day August 13), founder of the Knights of
Columbus (in 1882) and filled with a “zeal for
the proclamation of the Gospel and generous
concern for his brothers and sisters” that
“made him an outstanding witness of Christian
solidarity and fraternal assistance.
