THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

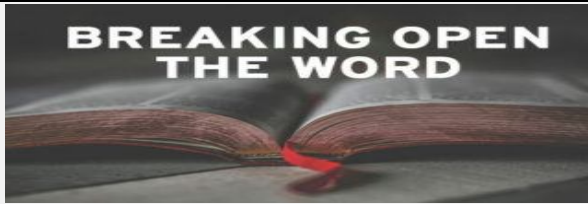

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

First Reading: Acts 14:21-27

Paul and Barnabas traveled to many towns and found many disciples willing to help them preach. They warned their disciples of the trials they would face. Paul and Barnabas then returned to Antioch, where their journey had begun, and told the congregation there of the progress they had made.

Second Reading: Revelation 21:1-5a

John had a vision of a new earth, and a new Jerusalem coming down from heaven. Then a voice described Jerusalem as a place where God would live among His people and comfort them. The former world had vanished, and pain, death and suffering had left the world as well.

Gospel: John 13:31-33a, 34-35

After Judas left the last supper, Jesus warned the other disciples that He would not be with them much longer. Jesus gave them a new commandment to love one another as He had loved them. He stated that their love for each other would distinguish them as His disciples.

Consider & Reflect

“After Paul and Barnabas had proclaimed the good news in that city they returned... to Antioch. They strengthened the spirits of the disciples and exhorted them to persevere in the faith, saying, ‘It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God.’ They appointed elders for them in each church, and with prayer and fasting, commended them to the Lord in whom they had put their faith.”

The book of Acts offers us a glimpse of the early church, its growth, the missionary journeys of Paul and his companions. Cities and towns not familiar to us today readily accepted their teaching, under the influence of the Holy Spirit. That same Spirit is calling believers today to go, teach and make disciples but we are slow to respond.

We lament the loss of family and friends who have given up the faith. We allow non-Christian practices to dominate the scene as far as morality and lifestyles are concerned. The sad thing is not what has led others away, but that we have not been the Paul and Barnabas for them.

Who needs to be strengthened in my circle of friends?

These will be combined grade classes, K/1, 2/3, 4/6, 7/8.

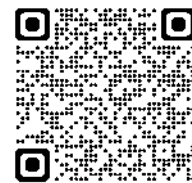

The Jubilee of Families, Children, Grandparents and the Elderly

May 30 - June 1, 2025

The joy of love in families is rooted in hope despite the challenges and trials that life presents us. The letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians reminds us that love hopes all things (1 Cor 13:4-7). It does not despair of the future. In fact, every family is a symbol of hope for future generations. Love, especially familial love, is rooted in the abiding promise of the Christ Child who came to renew all things and bring us everlasting peace. For this reason, despite the various trials, challenges, and sufferings whether hidden or revealed, which every family experiences, Christian hope endures. Many families demonstrate a strong sense of calling to bear their crosses with decisive hope. It is a tremendous testimony to see how God can use all things for the good of those who love Him. At the same time, supporting families in their time of great need is a powerful form of Christian witness that families can offer one another. **St. Joseph and the Blessed Virgin Mary** (multiple feast days), the earthly parents of Jesus, who together form the Holy Family and exemplify a model of family life centered on faith, love, and obedience to God’s will. St. Joseph is honored for his humility and obedience as a protector and provider, while Mary, Mother of God, is revered for her perfect discipleship and love through her acceptance of God’s will.

● **Sts. Joachim and Anne** (feast day July 26), parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary and grandparents of Jesus. After years of keeping a steadfast faith and trust in God amidst the trial of infertility, Sts. Joachim and Anne received an angelic prophecy of a birth of a child, Mary, Mother of God. They are the patron saints of grandparents and infertile couples.

Family Promise

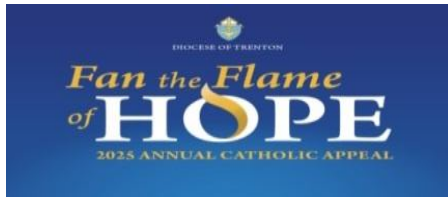
Hello All,

been hosting families by providing shelter and meals for several years, before and after Covid. The parish will be hosting once again this year for the weeks of **May 25th and June 1st**. We have simplified the process of providing breakfast, lunch and dinner to suit their needs, while providing a safe shelter for the families to sleep. In order to meet this challenge, we are asking for donations of gift cards to Walmart, Acme and Dollar Tree and to any of our local restaurants. The gift cards will be used to purchase the items needed while they are with us and the restaurant gift cards can allow the families to enjoy having a meal out at a restaurant or get take out while we are hosting them. If you would like to donate, you can drop them off in an envelope marked Family Promise, to the parish office, any time prior to **May 25th**. In the past, many of our parishioners have prepared dinner for the families. As we get closer to the dates of our host weeks, we will be contacting those that have prepared dinner for our families and those who have contacted me recently. 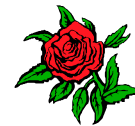
