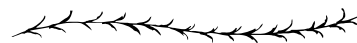

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

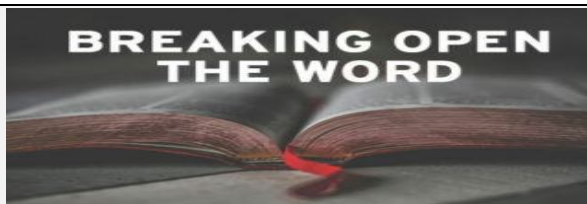

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

First Reading: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

Some men informed the Gentiles that they must be circumcised if they wished to be saved, because of the Old Laws. Disciples then went forth to tell the Gentiles to honor only those rules which were strictly necessary, such as abstaining from eating meat sacrificed to idols and illicit sexual union.

Second Reading: Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23

John depicts Jerusalem coming out of heaven, sparkling with the radiance of precious jewels. Angels were stationed at each of its twelve gates, and each gate bore the name of one tribe of Israel. The city had no temple, because God was its temple. The glory and light of God and the Lamb also replaced their need for the sun.

Gospel: John 14:23-29

Jesus tells his disciples, "Anyone who loves me will be true to my word." For those who do honor His word, both Jesus and God will love them and stay with them always. He also tells them that God will send the Holy Spirit in His place to give them the instructions they will need. Jesus then tells them that peace is His farewell gift to them.

Consider & Reflect

"Jesus said, 'Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him... I have told you this while I was still with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send you in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of everything I have taught you... Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you.'"

How often Jesus' role is described as teacher, preacher and miracle worker. Today He places emphasis on His teaching mission as He promises to send the Holy Spirit to teach and remind us of His message. The Lord knows we sometimes forget and need to be reminded of His word and His wish to abide with us. As He was preparing to take leave, He knew we needed additional help and for this reason promises us a gift. He offers us the gift of His peace. Do you still have it? Can you make it your gift for someone else? It was given to you to be given away.

The joy of love in families is rooted in hope despite
the challenges and trials that life presents us. The
letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians reminds us that
love hopes all things (1 Cor 13:4-7). It does not
despair of the future. In fact, every family is a symbol
of hope for future generations. Love, especially
familial love, is rooted in the abiding promise of the
Christ Child who came to renew all things and bring
us everlasting peace. For this reason, despite the
various trials, challenges, and sufferings whether
hidden or revealed, which every family experiences,
Christian hope endures. Many families demonstrate a
strong sense of calling to bear their crosses with
decisive hope. It is a tremendous testimony to see
how God can use all things for the good of those who
love Him. At the same time, supporting families in
their time of great need is a powerful form of
Christian witness that families can offer one another.
St. Joseph and the Blessed Virgin Mary (multiple
feast days), the earthly parents of Jesus, who
together form the Holy Family and exemplify a model
of family life centered on faith, love, and obedience
to God's will. St. Joseph is honored for his humility
and obedience as a protector and provider, while
Mary, Mother of God, is revered for her perfect
discipleship and love through her acceptance of
God's will.

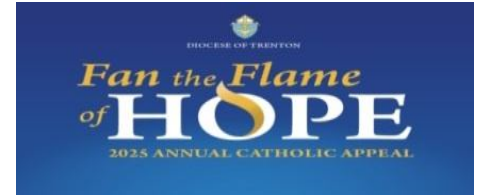

Office of Child and Youth Protection

The Diocese of Trenton reports any allegations of sexual abuse to the appropriate law enforcement agencies. Anyone with an allegation is also encouraged to provide that information to local law enforcement authorities.
