THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY
TIME

First Reading: Genesis 18:20-32

Abraham pleads with the Lord, who planned to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah because of the evil and sin in those cities. Abraham asks Him if he would spare the city if fifty, forty, thirty, twenty or even only ten innocent people were found there. God says that He would spare the cities even for the sake of only ten.

Second Reading: Colossians 2:12-14

Paul explains to the Colossians that through baptism, they are raised to life with Christ because they believed in the power of the God who raised Him from the dead. Even though they once lived in sin, their sins have been pardoned through Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 11:1-13

Jesus' disciples asked Him how they should pray. He gave them some phrases similar to those now used in the Lord's prayer. Jesus also reminds the disciples how even men with sins are able to give good things to their children, and explains how much more the heavenly Father wants to give to us.

Consider & Reflect

“Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of the disciples said to him, ‘Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.’ He said to them, ‘When you pray, say...Our Father...’”

How frequently we spy Jesus alone, in a deserted place, praying, in communion with His Father. The disciple asked that He teach them, already familiar with the call of John to repentance. Jesus offered what He also teaches us, a prayer of praise, of gratitude, of repentance and petition. We repeat this formula constantly.

There are prayers too, which go beyond words, known as mental prayer, contemplation, or a very common prayer practice taken from the scripture, where a biblical passage becomes the source of meditation. Perhaps the easiest way to pray as a disciple is to remember, our prayer is our intimate conversation with the closest friend I have. I speak; I listen!

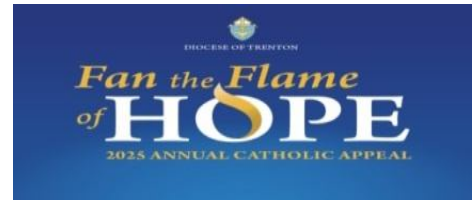

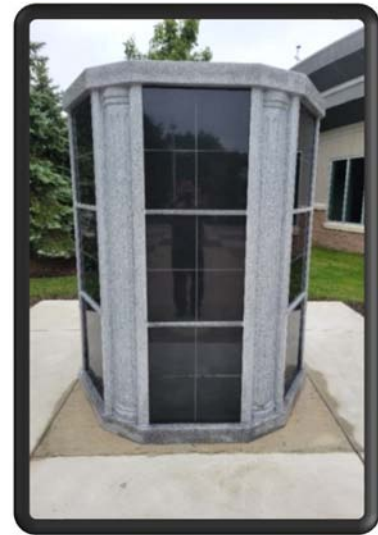

Office of Child and Youth Protection

JUBILEE 2025

The Jubilee of Young People (Young Adults)

July 28 – August 3, 2025

The Jubilee of Young People (Young Adults*) will be held from Monday, July 28, to Sunday, August 3, 2025 (which will include the canonization of Pier Giorgio Frassati); however, these resources can be used for engaging and celebrating young adults at any time throughout the Jubilee Holy Year. (*) *It should also be noted that the official language used for this particular celebration on the Vatican calendar calls it a Jubilee of "Youth" or "Young People." These are international terms that refer to women and men from about age 18 to 35, what those in the United States would call "young adults." With this in mind, the USCCB affirms this celebration for any person from the age of 18 through their 30s, single or married, with or without children, which is the "young adult" definition established in Sons and Daughters of the Light (USCCB, 1996) and reaffirmed in Listen, Teach, Send (USCCB, 2024).* Despite the struggles that they face daily, the young adults are called to something greater than whatever realities and hardships may be weighing heavily upon them. The occasion of this Jubilee Holy Year, rooted in hope, can be the opportunity for young people to renew their belief in a God who conquers the darkness and overcomes the pain, anguish, and concerns of the world. Why should young adults place their hope in this? Simply put: Jesus Christ overcame the greatest despair of death through the Resurrection. The Catholic Church is a faith community founded upon the Paschal Mystery, a series of moments and events in the life, death, Resurrection, and Ascension of the Lord, culminating in the sending of the Spirit at Pentecost. This great trajectory is filled with great hope. Christ shows us nothing is impossible with God.

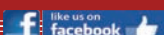
