

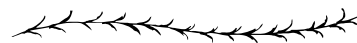

### THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least 2 months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

### THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least 1 year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

### THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*<sup>130</sup>

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail them of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

**NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**First Reading: Wisdom 18:6-9**

In this excerpt, the Israelites are reminded that they were warned before God sent an angel to slay the first born of the Egyptians. God called on them to have courage, and then rewarded them by punishing their enemies and leading them from captivity.

**Second Reading: Hebrews 11:1-2, 8-19**

Faith is described as true belief even toward things we cannot see. Abram's faith in God was so deep that he wandered through a foreign land, convinced God's promise of a homeland was sincere. God honored His promise to give Abram many descendants, and was proud of the deep faith Abram and his people possessed.

**Gospel: Luke 12:32-48**

Jesus encourages us to be prepared for His return at all times, for He will come when we least expect Him. He tells of a master who entrusts his home to his servants, and fully expects them to be awaiting his return. In the same manner, Jesus can arrive at any moment and expects us to be prepared for His return.

**Consider & Reflect**

*“Jesus said to disciples: Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom. Sell your belongings and give alms. Provide money bags for yourselves that do not wear out, an inexhaustible treasure in heaven that no thief can reach nor moth destroy. For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.”*

Our lives are challenged by identity theft, protected by security guards, constantly reminding us of threats to our existence. Maybe I fail to hear Jesus simply telling me, as part of his little flock, that the Father has something more important for me to seek and protect, the kingdom, the church on earth, the life of grace, and the promised reward of eternal life.

We take for granted God's gift and love, the treasure of treasures, His grace in the sacraments, His word in our hearts. How often the scriptures tell us not to fear. My only fear is to fall away and not seize this moment to accept His gift. We often think of treasures in material terms as money, possessions, family, employment. They may be of value today. But what about tomorrow? Where is your treasure, where is your heart? Are your eyes fixed on the Lord and your salvation?

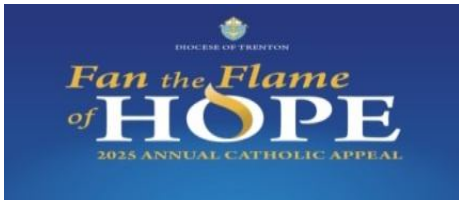
