TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29

Those who are humble will find favor with God. Everyone should realize that there is much we can learn from each other. Even the most knowledgeable people need to be humble enough to know that they can still learn from others.

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a

The Hebrews are informed that they are not approaching an untouchable mountain etched with gloom and fear. Rather, they have neared "the city of the living God, Jerusalem." The Hebrews have approached a joyful gathering of angels, God our judge, and Jesus, who brought us a new covenant.

Gospel: Luke 14:1, 7-14

Jesus went to share a meal with one of the leading Pharisees when he noticed other guests competing for places of honor at the table. He warned that a guest who takes the place of honor may be asked to move to the lowest place. Yet a guest who takes the lowest place is honored when a better position is offered by their host. He then added, "He who humbles himself will be exalted."

Consider & Reflect

"My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God...when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

The familiar prayer, 'Jesus meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto thine' is a worthy goal. It echoes the words from Sirach above or the teaching He gave at the leading Pharisees' house. We are advised not to be a social climber, getting ahead of others, but are told to reach out to the vulnerable who are not far away from us. It is easy to forget where we came from. Our needs are easily satisfied, and what I don't need, in the words of Saint Augustine, I am just a caretaker, which means I am to care for those listed by Jesus - the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind etc.

6 Things Catholics Should Stop Doing During Holy Mass

The Holy Mass is the highest form of worship in the Catholic Church. Yet, many Catholics unknowingly fall into habits that can distract from the sacredness of the celebration. Here are six things every Catholic should stop doing during Mass:

1. Arriving Late or Leaving Early

While emergencies happen, consistently walking in after the Mass has begun, or worse, leaving right after Communion, shows a lack of reverence for the full sacrifice of the Mass. Aim to arrive early and stay for the final blessing.

2. Using Phones for Non-Spiritual Purposes

Unless you're following readings on a Mass app or using it for prayer, phones should be silenced and stowed away. Browsing social media or texting during Mass not only distracts you but also those around you.

3. Casual Attire with No Reverence

Wearing immodest or overly casual clothing can downplay the sacredness of the Mass. Dress with dignity as if you're entering the presence of the King — because you are.

4. Chewing Gum or Eating

The Church calls for a one-hour Eucharistic fast before receiving Communion. Chewing gum in church is both disrespectful and breaks this fast. Save snacks for after Mass unless you have a medical need.

5. Talking and Whispering Unnecessarily

The church is a house of prayer. Chatting, even in whispers, takes away from the silence and sacred atmosphere meant for reflection, prayer, and awe.

6. Rushing Through Responses and Prayers

Mass isn't a race. Reciting prayers mindlessly or rushing through responses reduces their meaning. Pray each word with attention and devotion as a true offering to God.

Conclusion

Mass is not just another religious service, it's the representation of Christ's sacrifice on Calvary. Let's strive to participate fully, consciously, and reverently, giving God the attention and love He deserves.




