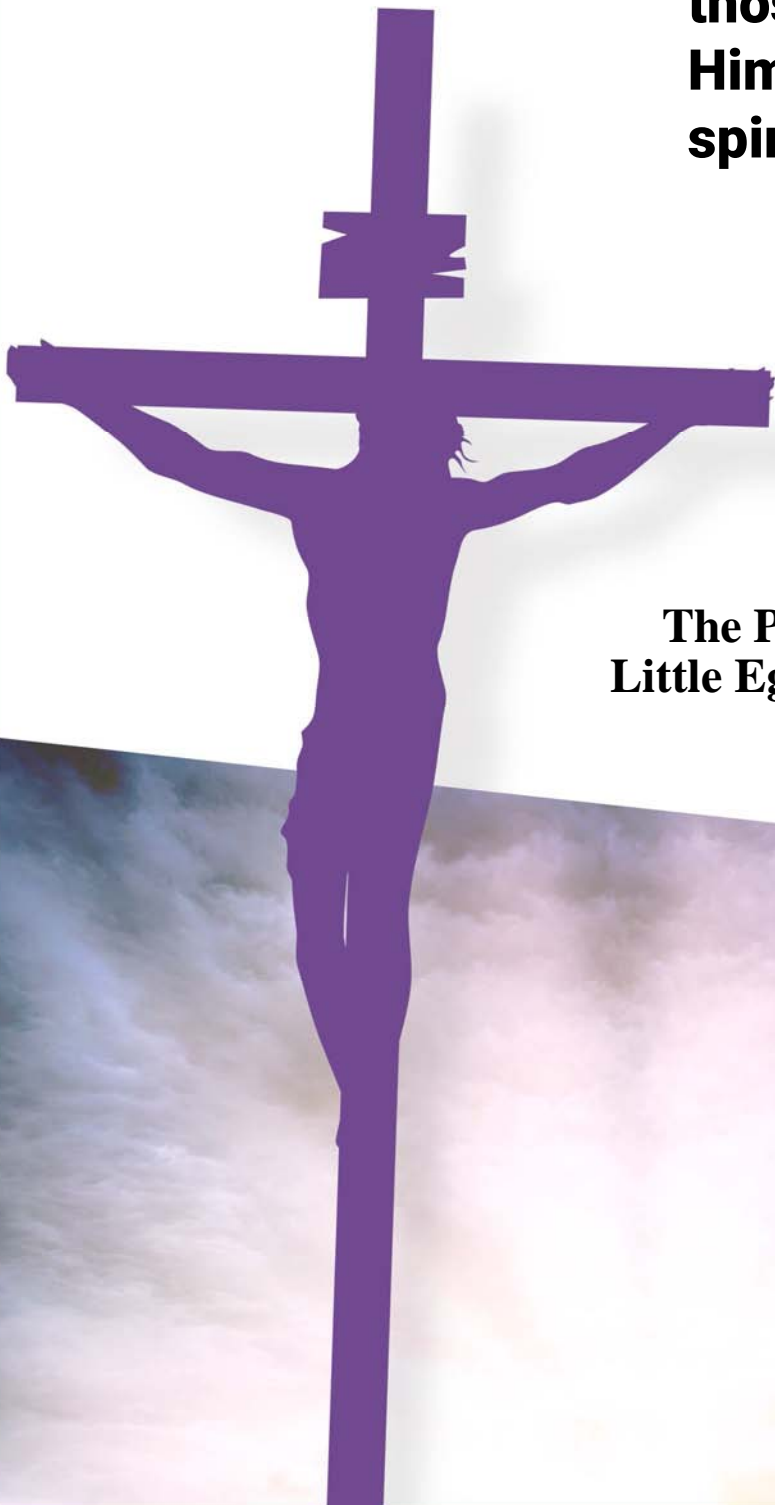

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held the first and third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least two months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.



THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is **no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.** A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*¹³⁰

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or under any emotional distress to avail themselves of this beautiful Sacrament. Please call the Parish Office to schedule the Sacrament with a priest. Please do not wait until the very last minute to call.

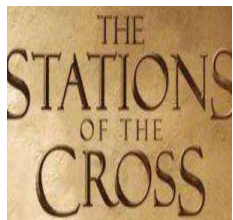

LENT

A SEASON OF REFLECTION,
RENEWAL, AND PREPARATION



THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

First Reading: Exodus 17:3-7

This story from Exodus reveals that, after they escaped from Egypt, the Israelites cast all blame for their sufferings on Moses. In this instance, they were dying of thirst. When Moses appealed to the Lord, the Lord directed Moses to strike a rock, and water would gush forth.

Second Reading: Romans 5:1-2, 5-8

Paul reminds the Romans that because Christ died for all people, they are acceptable in God's sight.

Gospel: John 4:5-42

Jesus converses with the Samaritan woman at Jacob's Well. When Jesus says that whoever drinks the water He gives will never be thirsty again, the woman immediately replies, "Give me this water, sir..." Jesus then reveals that she has had five husbands and tells her that He is the Messiah. The woman believes in Jesus and proclaims this news to all the townspeople, who believe her and come to see Jesus.

Consider & Reflect

"Since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith to this grace in which we stand, and we boast in hope of the glory of God. And hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. For Christ, while we were still helpless, died at the appointed time for the ungodly."

How reassuring listening to the words of St. Paul, a letter written before the four gospels. Think for a moment on the meaning of the words – justified, peace, grace, faith. Living in this holy year of hope, whose theme is taken from Paul's letter, 'Hope does not disappoint', we are both graced and strengthened as we continue our journey to Calvary.

'Lord Jesus Christ, have mercy on me, a sinner.'

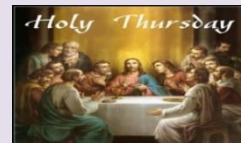

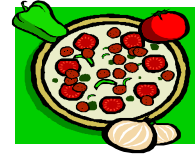
