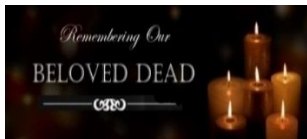

### THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held the first and third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Arrangements must be made in person at the Parish Office at least two months in advance. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class.

### THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance. Preparations include sessions with a member of the clergy and attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference. For more information, please call the Parish Office.



### THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us there is **no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick**. A careful judgment about the serious nature of an illness is sufficient. *"Hence, as soon as any of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived."*<sup>130</sup>

We welcome anyone who has a physical condition, is anticipating entering the hospital for surgery or tests, or is under any emotional distress to avail themselves of this beautiful Sacrament. ### **THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER**

#### **First Reading: Acts 2:14, 22-33**

After the Holy Spirit descends upon the apostles, Peter preaches with great enthusiasm to both Jews and Christians. He recalls for them in vivid terms the miracles and wonders that Jesus performed.

#### **Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:17-21**

Peter makes reference to the Passover, when the Jews escaped from Egypt because the blood of the paschal lamb was shed. Now they are being saved from sin by the blood of Christ, the Lamb of the New Testament.

#### **Gospel: Luke 24:13-35**

Jesus reveals Himself to two disciples on the way to Emmaus. After explaining to them the passages in Scripture which referred to Him, Christ "took bread, broke it, and distributed it to them." Then they recognized Christ and their "hearts burned within them."

#### **Consider & Reflect**

*"And he said to them, "Oh, how foolish you are ! How slow of heart to believe that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory...With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight....So they set out and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them who were saying, 'The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to Simon'."*

Our lives are often described as a journey. The disciples on the road, one named Clopas, and let's imagine, I am his companion. Saddened and disheartened, I'm walking away from Jerusalem, going home and then meeting someone who listens to my plight, and then says you know only part of the story. They invite Him to dine and then come to recognize Him in the breaking of the bread, eyes are opened, and joyfully we return to meet those they had left behind.

Where am I on my journey this Easter? Saddened, but He brings us hope. Wandering and lost, but I find someone to speak to me, especially in the word of God. My eyes are opened to the presence of the Lord, in the Eucharist, in my faith community, in the breaking of the bread at Sunday Eucharist.

Easter is once again today, for in reality we pray two words 'He lives'.

### **Reconciliation Room Window Blinds**

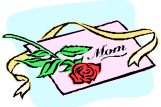
We are in need of some blinds for the windows in our Reconciliation Room.

- Remove all grass from the parking lot.
- Scrub all residual surface dirt with wire brush brooms.
- Crack fill seams of patches.
- Crack fill major cracks.
- Remove and straighten parking bumpers in handicap sections.
- Apply 2 coats of Neyra commercial-grade Sealer.
- Includes all original line striping plus yellow curbs instead of red.
