We are excited to announce a new software we are using in the parish. Mass Intentions Online. Managing Mass Intentions used to be long process. First, the Masses had to be manually entered into the Mass book. Then, as parishioners came in to request a Mass intention, we would have to open the book, find an available Mass, hand write the name of both the recipient and the donor. Later, the intention would have to be transcribed into the bulletin and display from the Mass book. Typo's, spelling errors and illegible entries often made it difficult. Today, this software completes all these tasks in minutes! Best of all, it can be done from anywhere! As always, you can still request a Mass Intention on our website, look for the banner on our homepage. This new software saves us time and most importantly, ensures that the data is accurate.
