

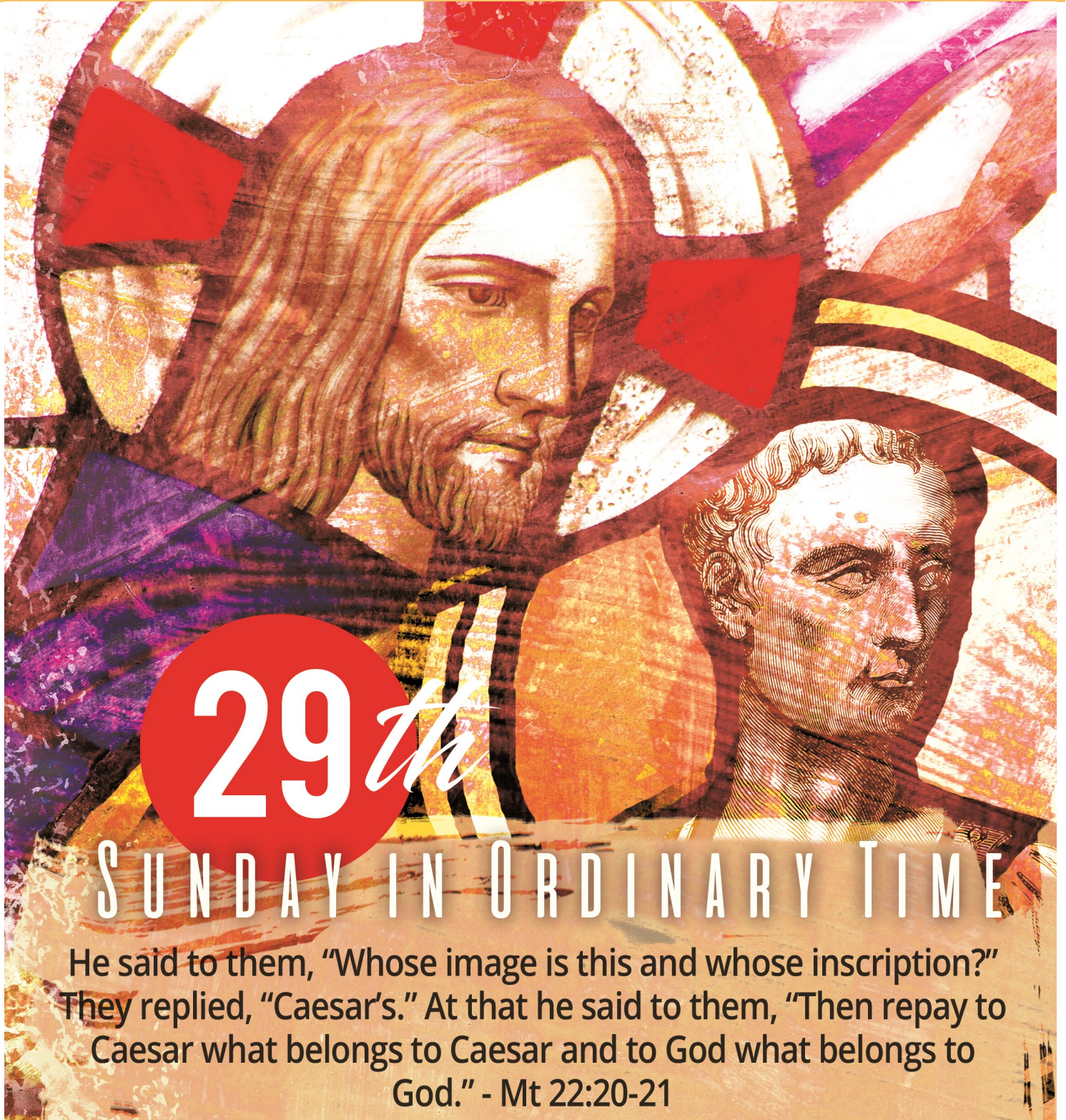

Spring into Ireland


Come Across the Sea to Ireland with us!

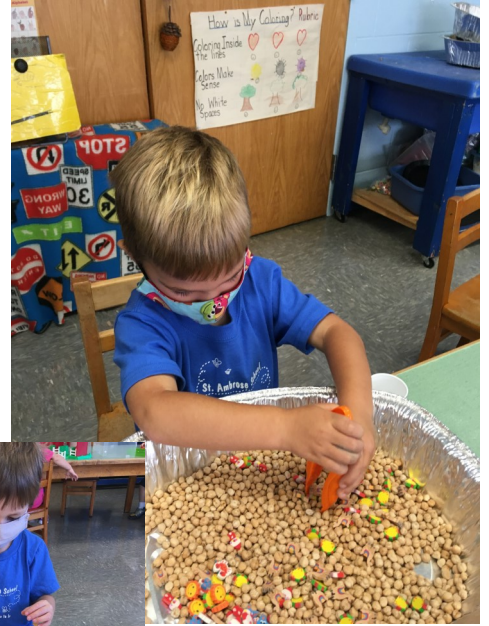

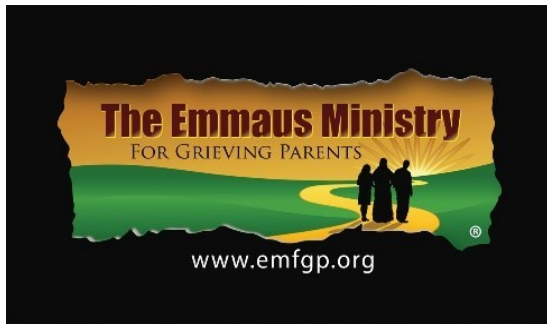
