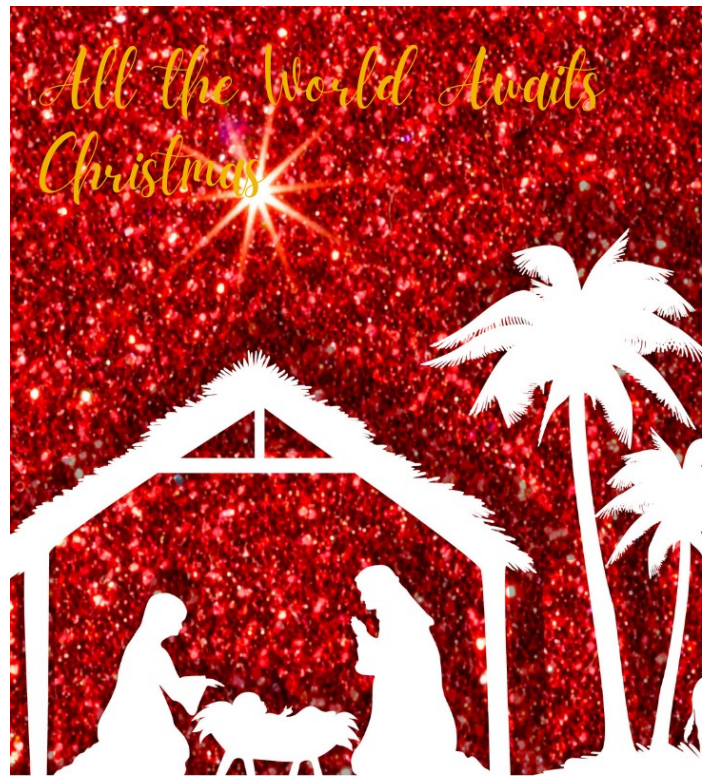

Serve: Last week we sent out the requests for those who serve regularly, to sign up and serve.

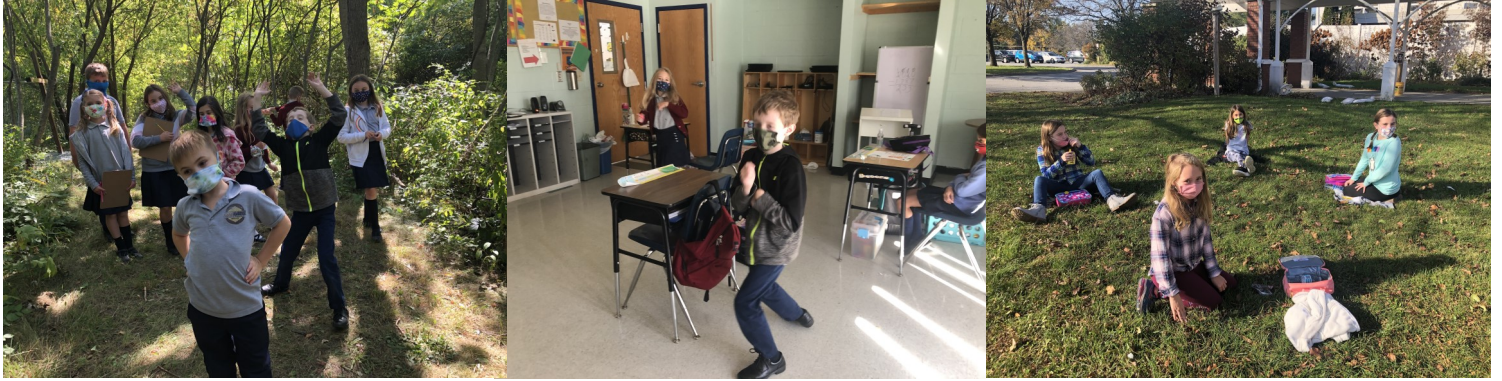
We still need lots of help and there's always room for more folks to serve. Please contact the parish office or go to our website.
