


As we rapidly approach Christmas Eve, we are putting the final touches on our preparation. We need your assistance and cooperation to make this happen.

As you know, Christmas Eve has been our biggest night of the year. If you have attended our Christmas Eve Vigil, then you know that this evening tends to be standing room only. As you will probably not be surprised to learn that gathering in the kinds of numbers we have in the past will be impractical if not impossible. We have made the decision that Christmas Eve Mass will be online only with a communion distribution opportunity following the stream of Mass. This was a difficult decision, but we're sure it's the right one. We will be streaming what is shaping up to be a spectacular Christmas Eve Mass, complete with all the beautiful music and decorations, and Christmas traditions you've come to expect. This will be followed by an opportunity for you to come to church and receive Communion.

We will be offering Masses on Christmas Day that you can attend in-person (8am & 10am, both in the Church and Parish Center). If you are planning on joining inperson on Christmas Day, we need you to register. That can be done a few ways: You can register online at our website www.stambroselatham.com and click on the button for the Christmas page at the bottom OR call the parish office and let them know which Mass you plan to attend and how many people you are reserving seats for.

Like we've done for some time, we'll need your assistance by filling out appropriate documentation as the date approaches.

Serve: Can you assist us on Christmas Eve with Communion Distribution or on Christmas Day?

Prepare: Attending in-person worship in Christmas Day? We'll need you to sign up in advance.

Holiday Gift Cookies (Dessert Cookies)

1 Box of yellow cake mix 1/2 Cup flour 1/3 Cup canola oil 2 Eggs 1(4oz) container of applesauce 1 6oz pkg. chocolate chips 1/2 Cup chopped pecans(optional)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees
Mix and blend well the first 5 ingredients in a large bowl.
Stir in Chocolate chips and pecans.

Bake in 350 degree oven 12-14 minutes. Enjoy!
