#### **Christmas Eve**

Be sure to watch our Christmas Eve programming on Facebook and YouTube! Mass will be at 3PM. (Keep an eye out for our full program schedule). Communion Distribution on Christmas Eve will run from 4-5 PM. We ask you to please fill out the COVID declaration form by 12/23. Here is the procedure to receive communion:

- 1-Put on your mask & go to the main entrance of the church. You will be "checked in" by a Welcome Minister.
- 2-Please proceed down the middle aisle of church. There will be 2 lines proceeding down the middle aisle, one on the left and one on the right. Walk carefully, giving plenty of space between you and the person in front of you (6 feet social distancing)
- 3-With your mask on, receive the host in your hand and step aside. At that time, you may pull down your mask and consume. Place your mask back on.
- 4-Please follow the arrows to exit the church.
