
Psalm 51

Today's designated Responsorial Psalm for the 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year C is Psalm 51. This psalm is a psalm of lament and repentance, usually heard during Lent as well as on Fridays during the Liturgy of the Hours. The responses normally used during Lent is either "Be merciful, O Lord for we sinned" or "Create a clean heart for me." However, today's response is "I will rise and go to my Father."

Today is also the 21st anniversary of that tragic day in New York City on Tues., Sept. 11, 2001. Our younger parishioners may have been too young to have lived through (or not yet been born) the events of that day. I do remember seeing more American flags on display on Wed., Sept. 12th. I do remember the churches were packed on the weekend of Sept. 15/16. Maybe many people took time to reflect that week on their commitment to our country and our God.

Perhaps this would be a good day to read and reflect on Psalm 51 and to recommit ourselves to our God once again. If we have been a little lax on our commitments, this would be a good day to rise and go to our Father.
