


THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST







MUSIC IN THE CHURCH BY BILL HAYES

Corpus Christi

Today is of the Solemnity the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, otherwise known in Latin as Corpus Christi. The feast of Corpus Christi was proposed by Saint Thomas Aquinas, Doctor of the Church, to Pope Urban IV in 1264 in order to create a feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist, In many countries, the day is a holy day of obligation and takes place on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. On that day, it is traditional to hold in the streets of a town or in an individual parish a procession with prayers and singing to honor the Blessed Sacrament. During the procession, the consecrated host is displayed in a monstrance held aloft by a member of the clergy. At the end of the procession, Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is held.

A well-loved Eucharistic song is "I Am The Bread of Life" by Sister Suzanne Toolan. She wrote the song for a San Francisco archdiocesan event in 1964. She was teaching high school at the time and wrote the song during a free period. When the bell rang for the next class she decided she didn't like the music, so she tore it up and threw it in the wastepaper basket. As she left the classroom, a freshman girl came out and said, "What was that? It was beautiful!" Sr. Toolan went back into the classroom, took the manuscript out of the basket and taped it back together. It has had a life of its own ever since.

"I am the bread of life. He who comes to me shall not hunger. He who believes in me shall not thirst. No one can come to me unless the Father beckons. And I will raise him up, and I will raise him up on the last day."
