

- 60 years old, I wish I could talk it over with Dad just one more time.










MUSIC IN THE CHURCH BY BILL HAYES

Psalm 100

Today's designated Responsorial Psalm for the 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A is Psalm 100 "We are his people, the sheep of his flock.", which is a psalm of thanksgiving, inviting all the people to enter the Temple courts with thanksgiving offerings for the God who created them. Although the people call on all the nations of the world to join in their hymn, they are conscience of being the chosen people of God, with 7 commands of thanksgiving: 1 Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all you lands! 2 Serve the Lord with gladness! 3 Know that the Lord is God! 4 Enter into His gates with thanksgiving. 5 Be thankful and say so to Him. 6 Bless his name, and 7 affectionately praise His name.
