Eternal Father, Strong to Save

As we celebrate Independence Day on July 4th this week, one patriotic hymn that is sung is "Eternal Father, Strong to Save". It is a hymn written by William Whiting in 1860 inspired by the dangers of the sea described in Psalm 107. This hymn is commonly associated with seafarers, particularly in the naval armed services, and is often referred to as the "Navy Hymn." This hymn also has a long tradition in civilian maritime settings and is called upon by ship's chaplains and sung during services on ocean travels. In 1940, the U.S. Episcopal Church altered three verses of the hymn to include travel on the land in the second verse (referencing Psalm 50) and in the air in the third verse (referencing Genesis and Psalm 91) so as to include all the branches of the military. The Episcopal Church has further revised this version with opening line "Almighty Father, strong to save..." by adding the word "space" to the final verse, so it ends "Glad praise from space, air, land, and sea", acknowledging the possibility of space travel. The 1940 version incorporating sea, land, and air is shown below:

- 1. Almighty Father, strong to save, whose air hath bound the restless wave. Who bidd'st the mighty ocean deep. Its own appointed limits keep: O hear us when we cry to thee, for those in peril on the sea.
- 2. O Christ, the Lord of hill and plain, O'er which our traffic runs a main, By mountain pass or valley low; Wherever, Lord, thy brethren go, Protect them by thy guarding hand, From every peril on the land.
- 3. O Spirit, whom the Father sent, To spread abroad the firmament; O Wind of heaven, by thy might, Save all who dare the eagle's flight.. And keep them by thy watchful care, from every peril in the air.
- 4. O Trinity of love and power, Our brethren shield in danger's hour;, From rock and tempest, fire and foe, Protect them wherever they go, Thus evermore shall rise to thee, Glad praise from air and land and sea.
