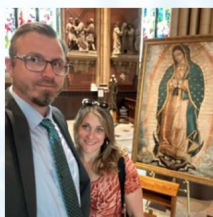

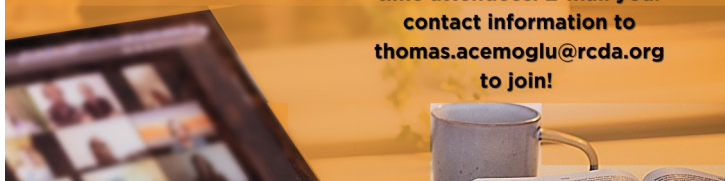

MUSIC IN THE CHURCH BY BILL HAYES

Alleluia, Sing to Jesus

The lyrics for "Alleluia, Sing to Jesus" were written by English, high Anglican, maritime insurance specialist, poet and hymn-writer William Chatterton Dix (1837-1898). It was first published in *Altar Songs, Verses on the Holy Eucharist*, 1867

The melody was written by Rowland Hugh Prichard (1811-1887) - most commonly used today under the hymn tune name of HYFRYDOL. He was a Welsh musician and lived most of his life in this area, serving for a time as a loom tender's assistant in Holywell, where he died. In 1844 Prichard published *Cyfaill y Cantorion* (The Singer's Friend), a song book intended for children. He also wrote "Come, Thou Long Expected Jesus", which is a 1744 Advent and Christmas carol common in Protestant hymnals.
