

Each year we celebrate our mothers during the month we venerate all our mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary who is Queen of Heaven and Earth. Mary has a special and prominent place among the saints. Mary said yes to God's request to be the mother of His Son and savior of humanity. The Second Vatican Council wrote this about Mary: "Redeemed by reason of the merits of her Son and united to Him by a close and indissoluble tie, she is endowed with the high office and dignity of being the Mother of the Son of God, by which account she is also the beloved daughter of the Father and the temple of the Holy Spirit. Because of this gift of sublime grace she far surpasses all creatures, both in heaven and on earth. At the same time, however, because she belongs to the offspring of Adam she is one with all those who are to be saved" (Lumen Gentium #53). Mary, a human being in need of salvation, said yes to God's will and fulfilled a crucial role in His plan of salvation.

During the Easter Season, the Church prays the *Regina Coeli* (rĕ-'jē-nä chā-lē) invoking the Blessed Mother to obtain, through her intercession, the blessing of the risen Lord.
