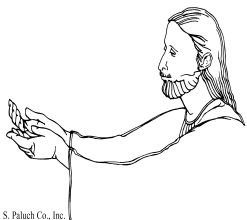
**Sacrament of Marriage:** Please register at the parish office as soon as possible, but at least six months prior to anticipated date.

July 9, 2023***A Message From Our Pastor**

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. In this beautiful quote from the 10th Chapter of John's Gospel, we are reminded of the great need we have to hear the voice of Jesus in our lives so that we can follow him in faithfulness and truth. Since the renovation of our parish church that brought in new flooring and pews, the current sound system has made it difficult to hear, and for many people, this has made it difficult to follow in our worship in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. While this issue is certainly a part of our current reality, it is being addressed and I wanted to give you an update on how this situation is progressing.

In February of 2023, a contract was executed between our parish and Prime Systems, an expert in audio systems who have significant experience with church sound technology. They have conducted a sound study of our church building and have custom designed a sound system to fit our space, resolve our current issues, and enhance our experience of worship, hearing the Word of God proclaimed, preached, and prayed in the Mass.

The delay in the installation of our new custom system has been that some of the gear for the project has been on back order for quite some time. Like with any good and necessary project, there is no use doing this half-way. Prime Systems has told us that they expect to have the equipment in by the end of July, with installation occurring when all the gear is in.

This is an important project, and what it serves is vital to our lives of faith. It is a significant investment for our parish, but one that serves to feed us with the Word of the Lord. Soon, with the completion of this project, the sound system issues will be resolved and we will once again be able to hear clearly the voice of our Good Shepherd who calls us all to follow him.

**FIRST READING** - Isaiah 55:10-11

Thus says the LORD: Just as from the heavens the rain and snow come down and do not return there till they have watered the earth, making it fertile and fruitful, giving seed to the one who sows and bread to the one who eats, so shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; my word shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it.

**SECOND READING** - Romans 8:18-23

Brothers and sisters: I consider that the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us. For creation awaits with eager expectation the revelation of the children of God; for creation was made subject to futility, not of its own accord but because of the one who subjected it, in hope that creation itself would be set free from slavery to corruption and share in the glorious freedom of the children of God. We know that all creation is groaning in labor pains even until now; and not only that, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, we also groan within ourselves as we wait for adoption, the redemption of our bodies.

**GOSPEL** - Matthew 13:1-23

On that day, Jesus went out of the house and sat down by the sea. Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat down, and the whole crowd stood along the shore. And he spoke to them at length in parables, saying: "A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell on the path, and birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, where it had little soil. It sprang up at once because the soil was not deep, and when the sun rose it was scorched, and it withered for lack of roots. Some seed fell among thorns, and the thorns grew

up and choked it. But some seed fell on rich soil, and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold. Whoever has ears ought to hear." The disciples approached him and said, "Why do you speak to them in parables?" He said to them in reply, "Because knowledge of the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven has been granted to you, but to them it has not been granted. To anyone who has, more will be given and he will grow rich; from anyone who has not, even what he has will be taken away. This is why I speak to them in parables, because *they look but do not see and hear but do not listen or understand*. Isaiah's prophecy is fulfilled in them, which says: *You shall indeed hear but not understand, you shall indeed look but never see. Gross is the heart of this people, they will hardly hear with their ears, they have closed their eyes, lest they see with their eyes and hear with their ears and understand with their hearts and be converted, and I heal them*. "But blessed are your eyes, because they see, and your ears, because they hear. Amen, I say to you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see but did not see it, and to hear what you hear but did not hear it. "Hear then the parable of the sower. The seed sown on the path is the one who hears the word of the kingdom without understanding it, and the evil one comes and steals away what was sown in his heart. The seed sown on rocky ground is the one who hears the word and receives it at once with joy. But he has no root and lasts only for a time. When some tribulation or persecution comes because of the word, he immediately falls away. The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word, but then worldly anxiety and the lure of riches choke the word and it bears no fruit. But the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold."

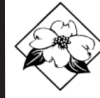

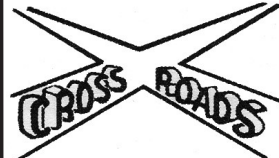
