In 2023, he joined Marian Missionaries Sisters Ad Regnum Dei as professor of liturgical theology, conducting virtual lectures, and he is also Religious Minister to the Daughters of Mary Mother of Mercy Congregation, USA and Canada. He has authored various books, articles and periodicals and resides in Maryland.



**Next Sunday Readings August 31, 2025****FIRST READING** - Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29

My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God. What is too sublime for you, seek not, into things beyond your strength search not. The mind of a sage appreciates proverbs, and an attentive ear is the joy of the wise. Water quenches a flaming fire, and alms atone for sins.

SECOND READING - Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a

Brothers and sisters: You have not approached that which could be touched and a blazing fire and gloomy darkness and storm and a trumpet blast and a voice speaking words such that those who heard begged that no message be further addressed to them. No, you have approached Mount Zion and the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and countless angels in festal gathering, and the assembly of the firstborn enrolled in heaven, and God the judge of all, and the spirits of the just made perfect, and Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and the sprinkled blood that speaks more eloquently than that of Abel.

GOSPEL - Luke 14:1, 7-14

On a sabbath Jesus went to dine at the home of one of the leading Pharisees, and the people there were observing him carefully. He

told a parable to those who had been invited, noticing how they were choosing the places of honor at the table. "When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not recline at table in the place of honor. A more distinguished guest than you may have been invited by him, and the host who invited both of you may approach you and say, 'Give your place to this man,' and then you would proceed with embarrassment to take the lowest place. Rather, when you are invited, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes to you he may say, 'My friend, move up to a higher position.' Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table. For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." Then he said to the host who invited him, "When you hold a lunch or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or your wealthy neighbors, in case they may invite you back and you have repayment. Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

It is no secret that we have struggled with the acoustics in the church for several years now. I want to personally thank you for your patience and understanding as we have tried to resolve the situation, even though I know it seemed like very little was happening at times. You may remember, in the summer of 2023, I promised you that one day both the AC and sound system would work correctly, at the same time. The fulfillment of that project is near at hand!

For the last several months we have been working with Applied Finish Systems to manufacture and install acoustical sound panels throughout the church to absorb the echo that reverberates, ad nauseum, in that long central barrel vault on the nave. The panels were delivered and are in the rectory garage. The crew deemed it best to begin installation on Monday, August 25th, with anticipated completion by end of day Thursday of the same week. Deo gratias!


